We came across a card the other day showing the stern wheel steamers Hazelton and Inlander just east of Kitselas Canyon on the Skeena River. This was in 1910 when grade construction was going full blast, the longest bar in the west was at Hazelton, Prince Rupert real estate was a short-cut to easy money, everyone who felt like working had a job and no one worried about war, past, or prospective. The main risk was sailing the surging waters of the canyon where the Mount Royal had been shattered and men drowned not long before. It was a great life, and nobody weakened.
