Bishop W. F. Barfoot of Edmonton Principal Visitor-Two New Priests Ordained

Distinguished guest of the Anglican Synod opening today and continuing Thursday is Bishop Walter F. Barfoot of Edmonton, who arrived with his wife on the train last night.

Bishop Barfoot is no stranger to Prince Rupert and has visited here from time to time ever since the summer of 1926 when he was in charge of the Cathedral before the then Archdeacon Rix was made Bishop of Caledonia. He is a veteran of the First World War and was awarded the Croix de Guerre. For many years he taught in he theological colleges, being professor at Emmanuel College, Saskatoon, and warden at St. John's College, Winnipeg. He was made Bishop of Edmonton in 1941 and is acknowledged in Edmonton and throughout the district by the whole community


