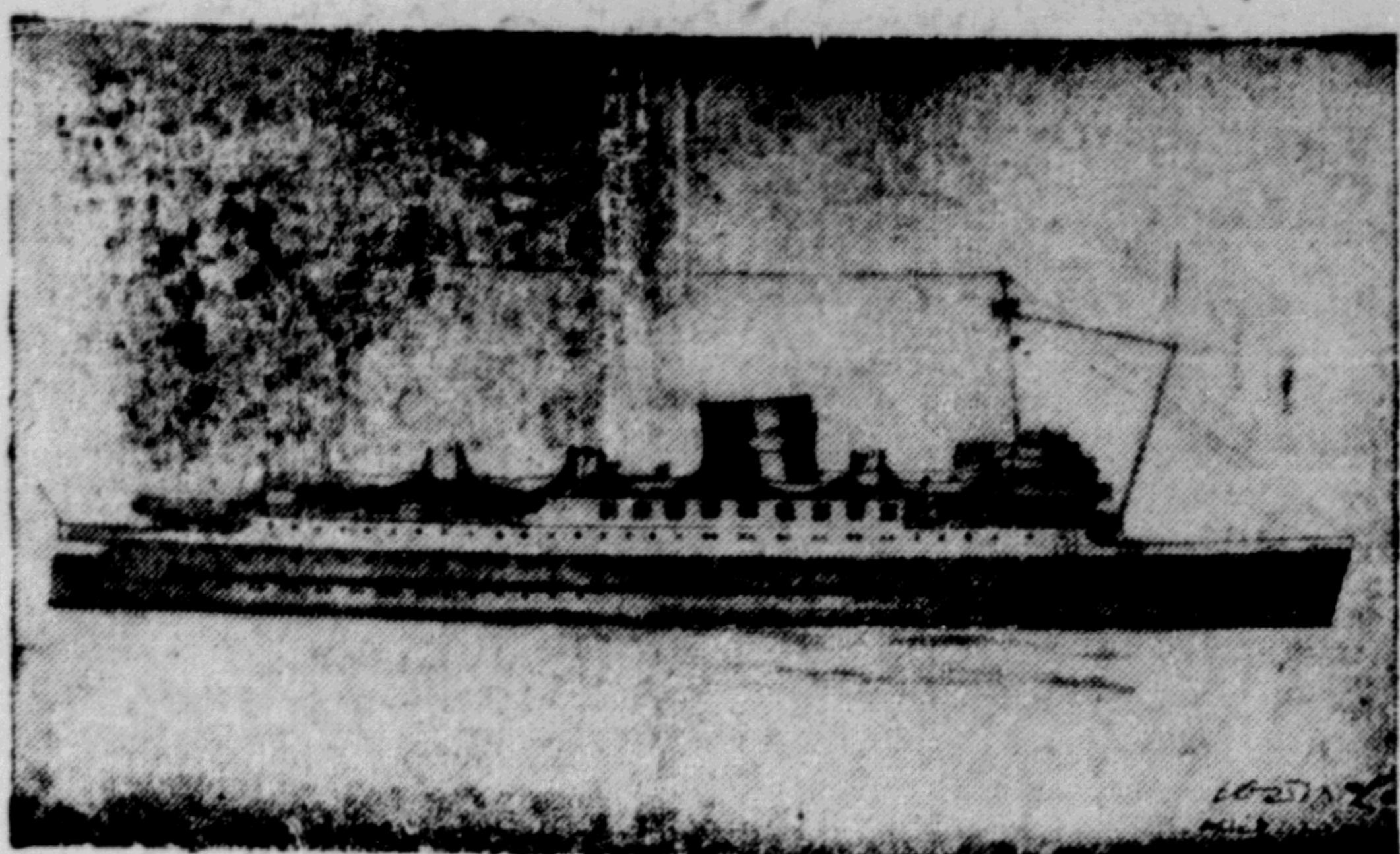
Court whist was the diversion of the evening with Mrs. Earl Gordon and Mrs. Victor Pick the prize winners.
