

## Nervous, Gyros Hear Of Halifax

Prince Rupert's "opposite number"—Halifax, history-steeped community of contrasts, 200-year-old warden of the North Atlantic—was the subject of an interesting descriptive discourse by Indian Superintendent F. Earl Anfield in addressing the Prince Rupert Gyro Club at luncheon yesterday. Mr. Anfield visited Halifax last September when he attended a synod of the Anglican Church in Canada.

A historical review of the Nova Scotia port, which had its founding July 14, 1750, with the landing of Edward Cornwallis as first governor of Nova Scotia, to set up the fortress which was to play such an important part in the British exploits in Canada, precluded a description of the present day Halifax which had for two hundred years been the great naval and military base—ever since the three years that General James Wolfe had made it his base for the campaign which was to lead to the capture of Quebec and the British conquest of all Canada.

Mr. Anfield told of the dire straits of Halifax, the negro section, the efficient rapid transit system of trolley buses—the combination of the old-fashioned and the modern.

It was something to be deplored, felt Mr. Anfield, that the ancient citadel of Halifax, a \$30,000,000 fortification from which never a shot had been fired, should be today going to "pot."

President A. J. Dominato was in the chair at yesterday's luncheon. Guests were B. H. Parker of Prince Rupert and H. Langley of Vancouver.

T. H. Wilford introduced the speaker who was thanked by George Dawes.

## From Germany To Pr. Rupert

Elderly Mr. and Mrs. Richard Kraupner are shortly to leave their native home at Chemnitz, Saxony, in the Russian-occupied zone of Germany, for Prince Rupert to make their home in Prince Rupert with their son, Hugo Kraupner. They are due to arrive here on May 25, arrangements for their removal from the Old Country having been finally completed after long negotiation for it is no easy matter to get out of the Russian-occupied zone under present conditions.

It will be the first time that Mr. and Mrs. Kraupner, both seventy years of age, have ever been out of Germany. On March 3, 1945, they were bombed out of their home as the final allied blitz shattered the Reich from end to end. They lost everything and life during the five years since then has been one of hardship and privation, living in one room with crude boxes for furniture and only such food as the Russians chose to give them. Their other son, Hans, an opera singer,

was killed during riots in Paris following the Nazi capture while he was engaged in entertaining German soldiers in the then German-occupied capital of France.

1 cup sifted Robin Hood Flour  
1/4 teaspoon salt  
1 1/2 teaspoons melted shortening

1 cup milk  
2 eggs

1. Preheat oven to 475°F. (Very hot oven.) Place approximately 9 thick muffin pans or custard cups in oven to heat while making batter.

3. Beat eggs until thick and light. Add to flour and milk mixture, then add melted shortening. Beat for 2 minutes with rotary beater. Batter should be thickness of heavy cream.
4. Remove pans from oven and grease thoroughly (butter gives best flavor). Pour batter into pans, filling half-full.
5. Bake in a very hot oven 475°F. for 20 minutes, then reduce heat to 350°F. (moderate oven) and bake 20 minutes longer.

Serve warm. Yield — approx. 2 popovers.

**Mass Burial In Montreal**

MONTREAL—Permission is being sought from civic authorities to hold a mass funeral next Sunday for seven of the eight victims of March 2 Chinatown fire, a Chinese Nationalist League spokesman said last night. One of the bodies already has been claimed for private funeral. Five of the victims will be buried here, while the two others will be cremated. An inquiry into the fire, which levelled half a city block and caused an estimated \$1,000,000 damage, is scheduled to open tomorrow.
