# Burns Pension Plan Extended

CALGARY - Enlargement of the pension and group insurance plan of Burns and Company Limited and its five subsidiaries, effective April 1, was announced to the staff over the week-end at the company's head office in Cal-The privileges are made available gary by R. J. Dinning, president. to more than five thousand employees and will extend immediately to fully half the staff. It is a joint contributory pension plan and all employees who are more than thirty years of age with a minimum of five years of ervice are eligible.

In addition to pensions the company has brought into effect a revised scheme of insurance the terms of which provide a death benefit equivalent to one and one third year's salary. Group insurance for employees has been operated in the Burns organization for upwards o twenty-seven years.




