## PIONEER DIES

**John Walker Exley Was for Many Years City Hall Janitor Here**

John Walker Exley, one of Central British Columbia's oldest pioneers who became particularly well known as janitor of the City Hall here for many years, passed away in Smithers Saturday evening at the age of 87. He had been in failing health for the past two years but had only recently entered the Smithers Hospital where he succumbed.

It was in 1935 that Mr. Exley left the City Hall and proceeded to Smithers to reside on land which he owned between there and Telka. He was a native of England and followed the sea in his younger days. Predeceased by his wife several years ago, Mr. Exley is survived by one son, Ernest Exley at Smithers, and six daughters—Mrs. Chester (Clara) Thoman of Smithers, Mrs. Charles (Lena) Morris of Smithers; Mrs. Oscar (Edith) Carlson of Prince Rupert; Mrs. C. B. (Amelia) Leavitt of Prince Rupert and Mrs. Edward (Winnie) Kane of Prince Rupert. The funeral will take place in Smithers tomorrow afternoon. The three daughters in Prince Rupert—Mrs. Carlson, Mrs. Leavitt and Mrs. Kane—are leaving on tonight's train for Smithers to attend the funeral.

## MARRIAGE UNITY

Christian marriage is a union which is part of the greater spiritual unity which is God's plan for the universe, Rev. Basil S. Prockter told his congregation in a special marriage evening address at St. Andrew's Cathedral Sunday evening. Couples who had been married in St. Andrew's during its long history were specially invited. The problem of marriage and of the home are the greatest that people know because they are the most intimate and the most continuous, he declared. "There are other problems, often serious ones, but they cannot help but be submerged by the closer ones which surround us in our married lives," he said. Mr. Prockter said that he believed it is "a great sadness" that people should wish for and expect happiness for newly married couples. The aim of marriage is not happiness but useful service in Christ. "Key to Christian marriage is Christ's statement that 'they shall be of one flesh' and it is in this unity the marriage ceremony has its basis. The beauty and comprehensiveness of the marriage ceremony is one to which few ministers take the liberty of adding words of their own, he declared, mainly because nothing could be said to improve on its pointness or beauty. Marriage itself is a sharing, a giving and taking because of the stresses inherent in human relationships. "If a marriage is running too smoothly, someone should indulge in self-examination and find out if perhaps he is not doing too much taking and not enough giving.
