The experts now are ready with the administrative machinery, but the constitutional machinery, demanding a treaty which must be passed by the parliaments of all three countries concerned, is slowing down the program.

Postponement Good In some ways, a postponement for a few months may prove to be all to the good.

One Dutch economist told me: "a little delay now can only produce good results, provided that it is made clear that it is due "solely to constitutional precedure and not to political or economic expediency."

Although the pre-union has been in operation for about a year, it is still impossible to. proof that it has been advantageous to all three countries the Dutch have had to pay more for their gasoline and the Belgians more for their beer. This was the result of an agreement by both the governments to bring their respective prices for thse commodities nearer to a common level.

Yet gasoline is cheaper in Holland than in any other country in Europe. It is probable that if the price had not been raised under the Benelux scheme, the finance minister. faced with a deficit budget. would certainly have looked in that direction for more money.

It is admitted in Benelux cirles here that the whole plan has a long-term rather than a short-term attraction and that the man-in-the street must not expect any sudden or spectacuor changes in life or conditions.
