Plans For Relief Work Under Way

A letter from J. G. Alley, president of the Vancouver branch of the Young Liberal Association of British Columbia, was read to members of city council Monday night, suggesting that this city notify Premier Byron Johnson in Victoria, of any projects in Prince Rupert or municipality which would qualify for assistance under the Dominion Municipal Improvements Assistance Act of 1938.  
The Association, alarmed by the increasingly urgent unemployment situation in British Columbia, wired Premier Johnson recently and suggested he approach responsible Dominion officials with a view to instituting immediate Public Works projects in this province either through use of the above mentioned 1938 Act or through Dominion planned projects to the value of \$138,000,000 on shelf.  
In 1938 Dominion surveys were made in this area, with a view of commencing projects should unemployment become serious.

Tenders for the installation of a 1800 foot sewer outfall, 145 feet west of the easterly boundary of McBride Street, down Third Avenue to Cow Bay were ordered called for at a meeting of city council Monday night. Diameter of the pipe will be 42 inches increasing to 48 inches at Cow Bay.
