KNOBBY FRUIT LOAVES

● Scald 1½ c. milk, 2½ c. granulated sugar, 2 tps. salt and 1½ c. shortening; cool to lukewarm. Meanwhile, measure into a large bowl 2½ c. lukewarm water, 3 tps. granulated sugar; stir until sugar is dissolved. Sprinkle with 3 envelopes Fleischmann's Royal Fast Rising Dry Yeast. Let stand 10 minutes, THEN stir well. Add lukewarm milk mixture and stir in 2 well-beaten eggs, 1½ c. maraschino cherry syrup and 1 tsp. almond extract. Stir in 4 c. once-sifted bread flour; beat until smooth. Work in 2 c. seedless raisins, 1 c. currants, 1 c. chopped candied peels, 1 c. sliced maraschino cherries and 1 c. broken walnuts. Work in 3½ c. (about) once-sifted bread flour. Knead on lightly-floured board until smooth and elastic. Place in greased bowl and

grease top of dough. Cover and set in a warm place, free from draught. Let rise until doubled in bulk. Punch down dough, turn out on lightly-floured board and divide into 4 equal portions; cut each portion into 20 equal-sized pieces; knead each piece into a smooth round ball. Arrange 10 small balls in each of 4 greased loaf pans (4½" x 8½") and grease tops. Arrange remaining balls on top of those in pans and grease tops. Cover and let rise until doubled in bulk. Bake in moderate oven, 350°, about 1 hour, covering with brown paper after first ½ hour. Spread cold loaves with icing. Yield—4 loaves. Note: The 4 portions of dough may be shaped into loaves to fit pans, instead of being divided into the small pieces that produce knobby loaves.

HOW CAN I ???

Q. How can I remove blood stains from fabrics?

A. Soak in cold water for about an hour and then wash in warm water and white soap. If the stains are old, they can sometimes be removed by wetting with cold water and covering thickly with powdered starch. Allow to stand for several hours, then wash. If this is not effective, it might be necessary to use a bleaching solution after soaking.

Q. How can I make a good hand lotion?

A. Use equal parts of camphor and glycerine. Rub the lotion thoroughly into the skin before retiring.

Q. How can I kill fleas?

A. Sprinkle salt about plentifully and it will kill fleas. Or, use spirits of turpentine in the water when rooms are scoured.

Timely Recipes

Spareribs and Rice

3 pounds fresh pork spareribs
1½ cups soy sauce
2 cloves garlic, crushed
1½ teaspoon salt
2 tablespoons sugar or honey
1 tablespoon sherry wine
3 cups cooked rice (1 cup uncooked)

Wash and remove as much gristle as possible from the ribs, and dry in a towel. Place the remaining ingredients, except rice, in a large deep bowl and mix well; let ribs soak in the sauce 10 minutes; move occasionally so that the flavor soaks in evenly. Place the ribs on the broiler and broil (basting occasionally with sauce from which garlic has been strained) until both sides are brown and well cooked. A little of the sauce and dripping mixture may be served over the rice if desired. Sauerkraut or a salad with sharp dressing is a good accompaniment for this dish. This will serve four persons generously.

Thirty Children Study Museum

About 30 children, mostly from grades 4 to 6, took advantage of the free afternoon Saturday to see the museum. It was the first organized day for school children at the museum.

Mrs. Margaret Ellis, who is spending the summer collating the collections, reports the children showed great interest and kept her busy answering questions.

The exhibits are arranged to show varying phases of Indian culture. There are some excellent items from the interior. One native woman spends some time at the museum practising her people's ancient art of basket weaving.

Although arrowheads feature strongly in the collection, Mrs. Ellis said they are used for hunting almost exclusively and not in fighting. There are also some harpoons, believed to have been used in whale fishing.
