### I imely Recipe

RICE AND HAM CREOLE 2 large onions

2 green peppers

1 cup chopped, frayed ham 3 tablespoons bacon drippings

or other fat

2 cups cooked rice

2 cups canned tomatoes

½ teaspoon salt

Cut onions and peppers in small pieces and saute lightly in the fat. Add rice, tomatoes, salt and ham. Mix well. Pour into a greased casserole or baking dish and bake in a moderate oven for about 25 to 30 minutes in a 375 degree oven. It doesn't matter which, but use the one that is most convenient for any other cooking that is being done for the meal.




