## ELECTRICITY SHOULD BE CHEAP, WIDESPREAD IN B.C. VISITOR SAYS

Why British Columbia is not one of the most electrified areas on the continent is a matter of puzzlement to Albert A. Thorson, of Portland, Oregon, who has pondered the matter while watching endless torrents of water tumble down mountainsides while on the deck of a cruise ship.

Mr. Thorson's interest in hydro power is a logical one, since he is an electrical contractor in the American city. Also, he is a native of Sweden which, he says, has made electricity a universal servant to an extent unequalled anywhere else in the world.

A round trip passenger on the Camosun, which docked here southbound from Stewart Tuesday, Mr. Thorson said that he was fascinated by the obvious hydro electric potential along the British Columbia coast.

"With all that fast water going to waste, there is no reason why every home in Prince Rupert should not be completely electrical," he said. "Electric power should be the cheapest commodity you have."

Its development could be a great drawing card for population and industry, he feels.

"Development and use of electrical power where it is available is more than a matter of convenience," he declared. "It is a hall-mark of civilization. In Sweden it is looked on as a cheap, efficient servant of all the people. Its luxury status disappeared years ago."

Argument that distances which power has to be transmitted in British Columbia are an added cost factor failed to impress the Portland visitor. Throughout much of the area, he said, are fruitful farm lands which need population and also there are additional sources of power which could contribute their small share to a mighty project.

"My observations in Europe and in the United States have convinced me that as a public utility, hydro-electric power can be developed and co-ordin-

The chunky little Belgian resigned yesterday as acting Premier and foreign minister so he could take over the job in the newly-created council of Europe.

Former Prime Minister Winston Churchill of Great Britain nominated Spaak for the Assembly presidency.

The 101 delegates from a dozen countries quickly endorsed the selection without opposition.
