## MOBILE ANTI-TB UNIT TO COVER CITY, INTERIOR

A campaign which will seek to ferret out unsuspected or incipient cases of tuberculosis in central British Columbia will begin in the Prince Rupert area on August 15 with the arrival here of two mobile x-ray vans

which will move inland after a week's visit.

The campaign, sponsored by the provincial Department of Health, has its local strategic centre at the Prince Rupert Health Unit which has organized a drive to interest people in having free x-rays taken to determine whether or not they are free of the disease.

According to Miss Joyce Leslie, senior nurse at the Health Unit, there has been a good response and a large list of names

has been prepared by a canvass of volunteer workers.

The mobile unit will consist of two vans, each with two technicians, who will make speedy x-rays of those taking advantage of the service. This is the third year that such mobile units have visited this area.

One of the vans will give coverage to industrial plants in this area, starting with the Nelson Bros. plant at Port Edward on August 15. The other will remain at the Health Unit where Prince Rupert people not x-rayed in the industrial circuit, will have an opportunity to be x-rayed.

The industrial plant unit will spend August 15 and the morning of August 16 at Nelson Bros., then move to the Columbia Cellulose plant where it will remain until the evening of August 17. This unit will then move to the Canadian Fish and Cold Storage plant at Seal Cove for a three-hour session on August 18, changing its location to the dry dock that same afternoon. It will spend three hours at Cow Bay on the morning of August 19, then move to the Fishermen's Co-operative plant

at Fairview Bay on the afternoon of August 19.

It will leave for Terrace on August 22 and cover interior towns as it moves eastward until September 2.

The "breakdown unit" which will be spotted at the Health Unit will be open to give x-rays for a two-day visit on August 30 and 31, then to Burns Lake September 1.

It will then move to Smithers for a two-day visit on August 30 and 31, then to Burns Lake September 1.

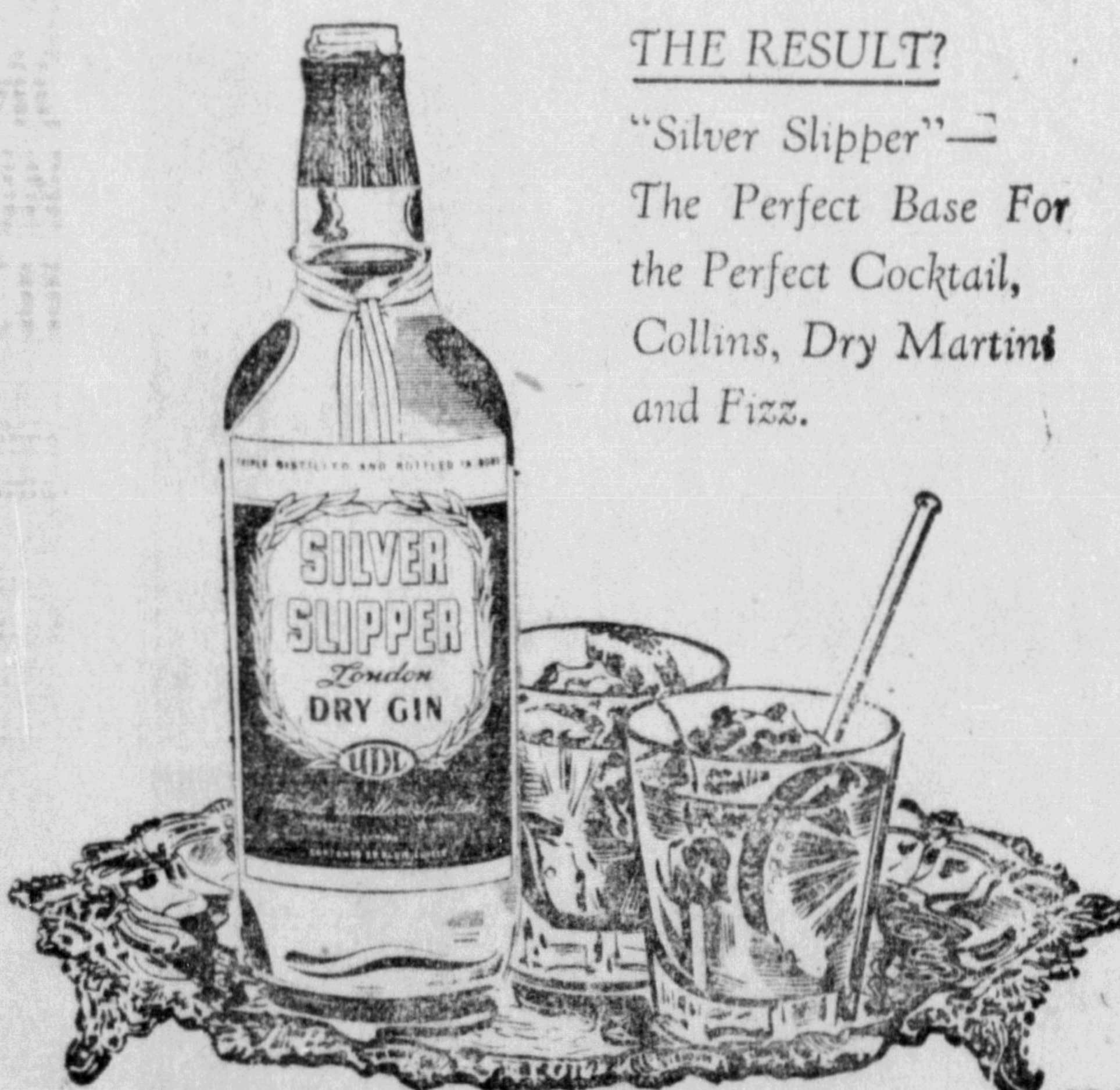
