

NEW 'LOCKER PLANT' OPENS

Rupert Freezing Plant Now Open To The Public

The newest business enterprise to be introduced to the citizens of Prince Rupert is the Rupert Freezing Company Limited which will be open tomorrow morning for the first time.

The "Locker Plant" was mainly constructed by Mr. H. S. "Hector" Cobb, with the able assistance of his father Mr. J. S. Cobb, a retired railroad engineer. The building that houses the "Locker Plant" was the former Loop indicator station from Ridley Island which served as a sub detection station during the war and is another one of this area's war assets to become

part of the community. The building was dismantled and brought to the City by barge where it was reconstructed on its present site. The new "Locker Plant" will be open to inspection by the general public from 9 until 6 each day and everyone is welcome to come and see this new business in operation.

New Owner-Manager "Hector" S. Cobb

The new owner-manager of the new Rupert Freezing Company limited is H. S. "Hector" Cobb who came to Prince Rupert originally in 1942 as a salmon fisherman. He liked the city and decided to lay plans for the building of a "Locker plant" here. Married in 1947 the Cobbs arrived in Prince Rupert to stay and as Mr. Cobb puts it: "There's a great future in Rupert and the north country if you're willing to work for it."

Smarily Finished Building Houses New Locker Plant"

With a latest type of aluminum finish and an almost complete glass windowed front the new "Locker Plant" houses the most up-to-date freezer equipment at present in use.

There are over three hundred and seventy-four individual lockers of sizes six, eight and ten cubic feet which will be rented to the general public. These lockers are cooled by two Kelvinator Compressors which keep the temperature at zero at all times as a guarantee to keep meats and foods fresh constantly. Another unit is the par compressor which is used for sharp freeze.

Two other very large locker units are housed in the building one for fresh fish and other sea foods which will be adjacent to the fish market section of the plant. While the meat refrigerator will be used for aging meats before they go into the deep freeze units.

The entire building has a V-joint interior throughout and a light varnished fir floor and mental butcher in 1944, will be the butcher in charge of the meat department and meat cutting in the newly opened company.

Mr. Mellor returned to Prince Rupert after his discharge from the Canadian Army and has been employed locally since then. He has a wife and son living in Prince Rupert.
