Is Dedicated To Father's Memory

Dedicated to the memory of his father, the late Giacomo Colussi, one of Prince Rupert's earliest settlers, is Colussi's Music Store which Mike Colussi, popular local accordionist and musical technician, has opened in the former Walker Music Store premises at Second Avenue and Fourth Street.

The late Mr. Colussi, who settled in Prince Rupert in 1910, was himself a keen music lover and teacher. He lost his life in 1938.

A favorite childhood recollection of Mike's is that of his father trying him out on his large model piano-accordion. All he could see was the ceiling. Years later Mike's father told him that he had shown promise of being "long" on enthusiasm and "short" on talent. Notwithstanding that, Mike has become a talented and popular musician and, during the war, in which he served with the Canadian Army overseas, his services were much in demand.

There was a "modest" opening of the music store at the end of last week but "there will be nothing modest about our service," says Mike.

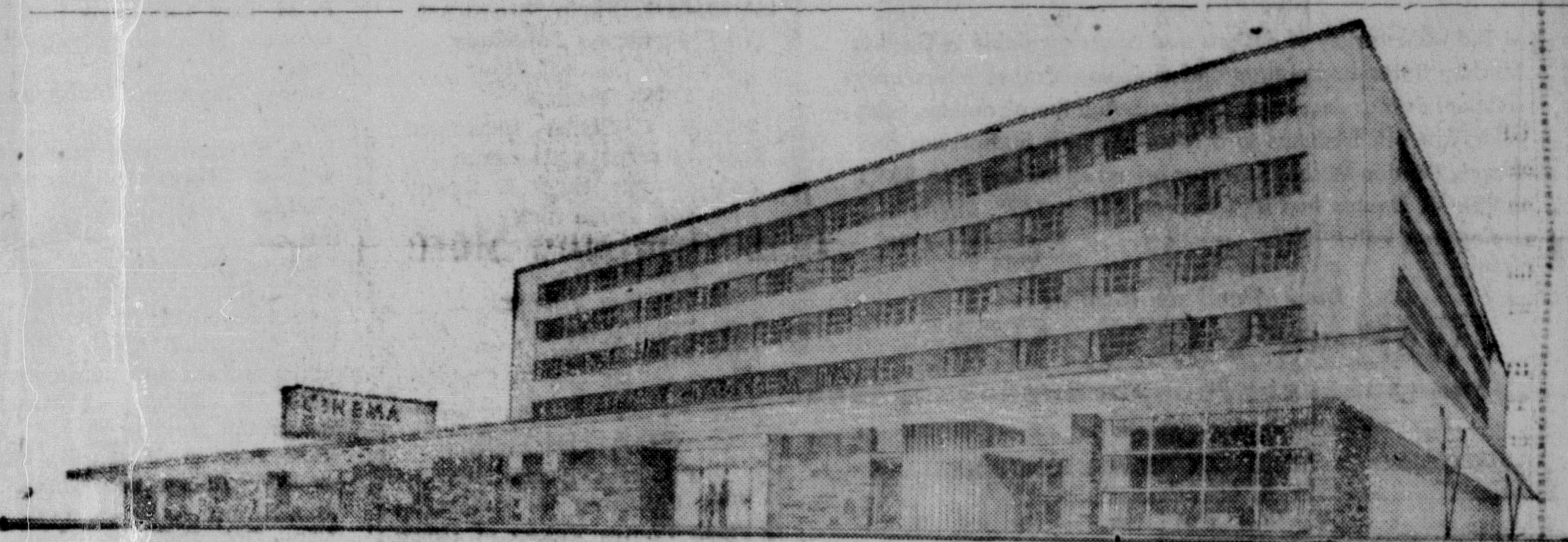
