The pattern now used is much the same as has been followed since gass first became available, and serves for both cold frame and hot-bed. The standard size is 1x6 feet, made to fit the standard sash, which was scarce during the war but is obtainable again. You can build your frame to fit any sash you have on hand. however, and instead of glass many prefer one of the plastic substitutes which are much lighter and unbreakable-important advantages in windy lo-

When it is practical to assemble the frame outdoors, dig hole in the ground slightly larger than the size of the frame. It should be at least a foot deep.
