Seasonable Ideas for Housekeepers

**HAMBURG GOES LONG WAY TO
SOLVE ENIGMA OF ECONOMY**

For budget-weary homemakers,
home economists have many
helpful suggestions.

The question of the meat
course is always pre-eminent
and the woman who can
serve "save-a-penny" meats in
ways that are appetizing has the
solution to the economy enigma
in her hand.

When tougher cuts of meat
are put through a mincer they
may be cooked as tender cuts.
Hamburg steak, sausage and
lamb patties are all in this
group which may be served with
no apologies.

Here are several new ideas for
serving these economical cuts.

YORKSHIRE BAKE

1 lb. minced steak

2 tablespoons minced onion
2 teaspoons salt
1/4 teaspoon savoury
1/2 cup cracker crumbs
1 egg
2 tablespoons milk
3 tablespoons fat

Mix all ingredients except fat.
Form into six flat patties. Melt
fat. Brown patties well on both
sides. Remove patties and keep
hot. Heat the pan to sizzling
in the oven at 450 degrees F.
pour in batter mixture:

1 cup flour
1/2 teaspoon salt
2 eggs

1 cup milk
Sift flour and salt. Beat eggs,
add milk and slowly add to flour.
Using a Dover egg beater beat
3 minutes. Pour into pan, place
patties on top and bake 10 min-
utes at 450 degrees F. Reduce
heat to 350 degrees F. Cook 20
minutes longer. Six servings.

**MEAT PATTIES WITH
TOMATO SAUCE**

1 lb. ground raw beef
1/4 lb. ground beef liver
1 small onion
2 teaspoons salt
1/2 teaspoon pepper
2 cups mashed potatoes
1 egg yolk
2 tablespoons fat
2 cups canned tomatoes

Mix meat, onion, seasoning,
potatoes and egg yolk lightly
together; shape into 12 patties.
Brown on both sides in hot fat
then cook slowly until well-
browned, 8 to 10 minutes. Re-
move patties to a hot platter.
Add tomatoes to pan, bring to a
boil and pour over patties. Six
servings.

**QUICK MEAT PIE WITH
BISCUIT RINGS**

2 cups cooked minced beef
1 tablespoon flour
1 onion, sliced
3 tablespoons mild-flavored
fat
1 1/2 cups mixed, diced, cooked
potatoes and carrots
1 teaspoon spicy meat sauce
1/2 teaspoon salt
1/8 teaspoon salt
1/8 teaspoon pepper

1 cup water (or vegetable
stock)

Mix meat with flour and brown
with onion in hot fat. Add vege-
tables, seasoning and water.
Cover and simmer 10 minutes.
Pour into casserole, cover with
partially baked biscuit rings (top
side down). Finish baking in a
hot oven, 400 degrees F., for 12
to 15 minutes. Six servings.

Tea Biscuit Rings—Roll biscuit
dough to a thickness of 1/2 inch.
Cut with a doughnut cutter.
Bake for 8 minutes in a hot oven,
400 degrees F., then use as di-
rected above.

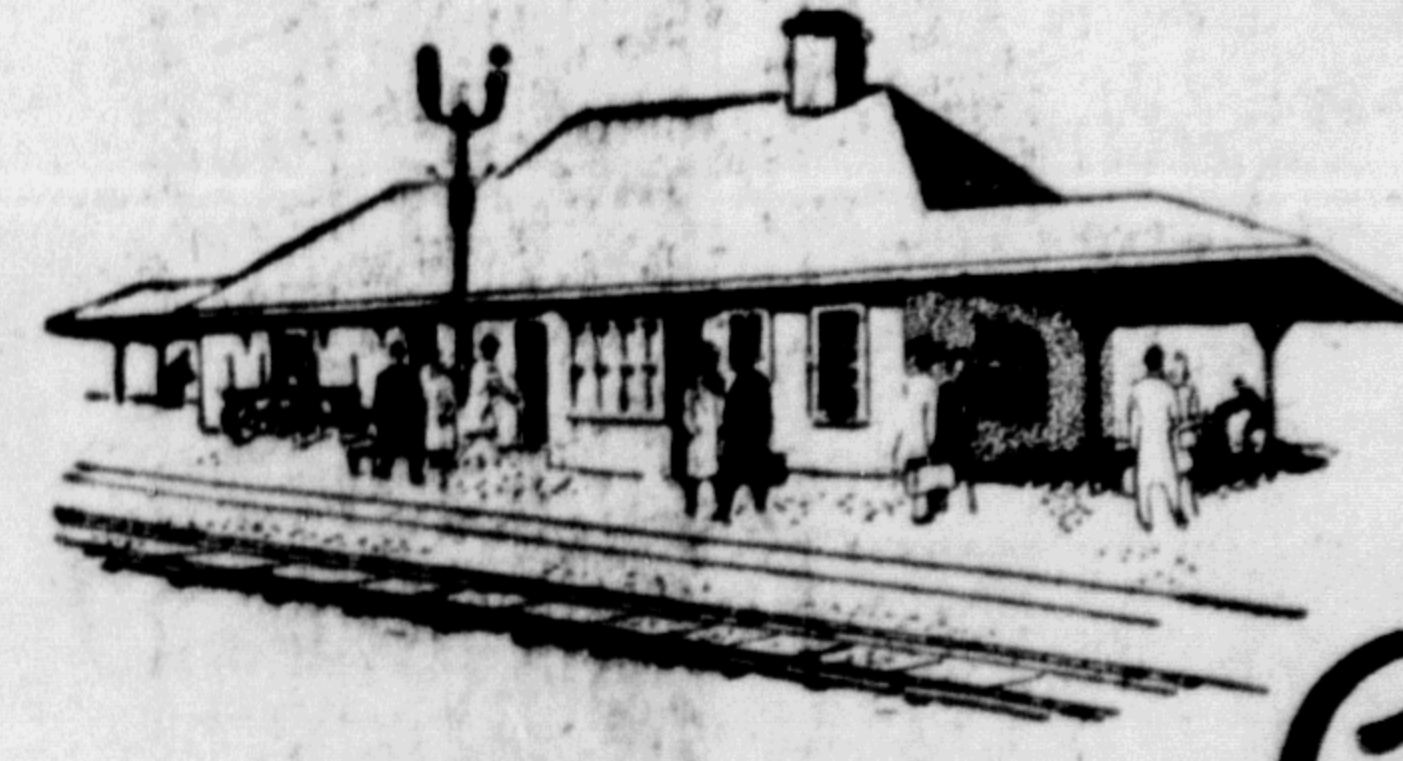

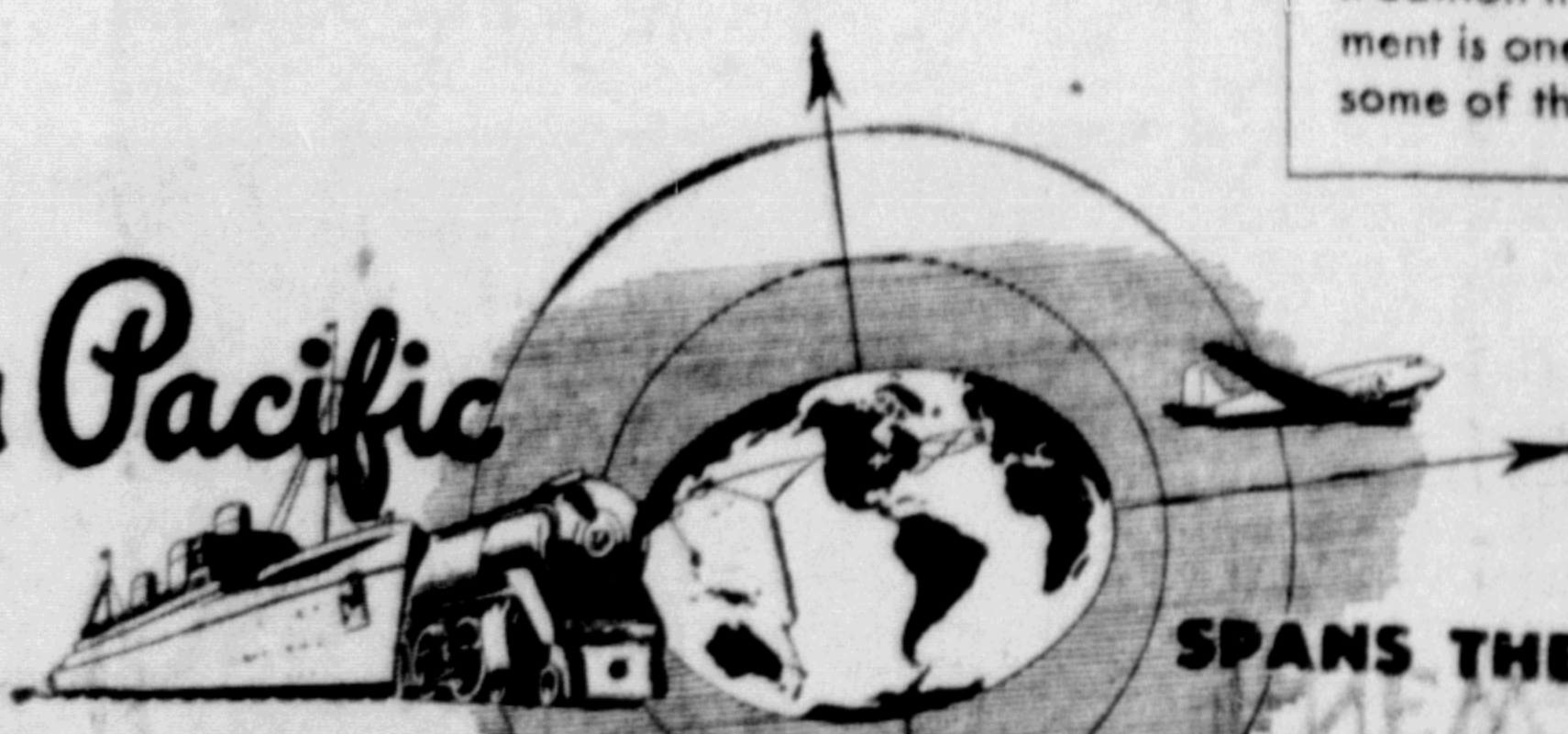
