FAIR SHARE FOR RUPERT

Prices and Trade Board Order Requires Vancouver Jobbers to Send Citrus Fruits

Prince Rupert produce dealers, who were fearful that they would be discriminated against by Van iouver jobbers through undue curtailment of citrus fruit shipments under the cut in quotas of imported fruit and vegetables from the United States and, appealed to the Prince Rupert Chamber of Commerce for support in their representations, . would now appear to be guaranteed protection under a new order of the Prices and Trade Board requiring that citrus fruits be distributed equitably among customers who purchased it during the base period from July 1, 1046, to June 30, 1947. A copy of the order is being sent to the Vancouver office of the Prices and Trade Board with the request that they bring it to the specific attention of companies supplying the Prince Rupert market.
