## Fabricating Of Fire Truck Here

A recommendation of the utilities committee to the city council at their regular meeting last night that Thor Sheet Metal works be awarded the contract for fabrication of the body for the new fire truck at a cost of \$941.42 was accepted.

In moving the award, Ald. W. J. McLean explained the committee had been unable to obtain a lower tender. Ald. J. N. Forman added that, although it was more than had been budgeted for, it was work that had to be done and the city would still get its fire truck cheaper than by purchasing it otherwise. Ald. T. B. Black said it might be possible to place the work under capital expenditure.

The committee also reported they had received and considered the report of the telephone superintendent for the period June 15 to June 30.

## Minister From Sweden Coming

Distinguished visitor in Prince Rupert tomorrow will be Per Wijkman, Swedish minister to Canada and also consul-general for that country. Accompanied by his wife and Mr. and Mrs. Olof Hanson, Mr. Wijkman will arrive on the Prince Rupert from Vancouver. After spending the day here they will proceed through to Ketchikan and will be in the city again Thursday evening southbound. Mr. and Mrs. Wijkman are making a tour of Western Canada and, after Prince Rupert, will visit Jasper and Edmonton.

## Will Meet Minister

President William Scow of the Native Brotherhood of British Columbia, while in the district, at the week-end, receive a request from Citizenship and Immigration Minister Walter E. Harris to meet him in Vancouver Friday. Reason for the meeting will be to discuss Bill 267 amending the Indian Act. Scow has been attending a number of meetings along the coast in order to get the reaction of as many natives as possible, the first meeting being at Casiar Saturday night.

## Too Busy To Come To City

The proposed housing scheme for the city of Prince Rupert came up for considerable discussion at last night's meeting of the city council on reading a letter from an official of Central Mortgage and Housing whom the council had hoped to get here to discuss with prospective home builders how the plan worked. The letter stated that, owing to the high demand in Vancouver for housing, he would have to stay there to look after it and would not have the time to come to Prince Rupert. The letter suggested the city contact another department that dealt with rental housing.

Ald. George Casey said he felt the city clerk had given the wrong impression of the problem in Prince Rupert when he had written, but, when Mr. Thain read the duplicate of the letter he had sent, the council was satisfied the letter had given a true picture of the situation here. Ald. T. B. Black suggested a full report from the housing committee be submitted to the council. He said the plan the city had in mind was not the N.H.A. but another under which the Dominion undertook 75 per cent of the cost of financing and the province 25 per cent.

Mr. Thain said that the plan still called for building under the N.H.A., that the Dominion-provincial payment was in respect of services only but that the down payment would be much smaller to the builder under the scheme.
