**URGES PACIFIC DEFENCE PACT**

OTTAWA - Canada, the leader in the drive toward North Atlantic security, has been urged to start thinking about defence in the Pacific. Howard Green (FC-Vancouver-Quadra), asked the government in Commons last night to take a stand in favor of a Pacific Pact.

"We believe there should be a Pacific Pact similar to the North Atlantic Treaty, a pact designed to hold communism in the Pacific," he said.

The Philippines are in favor of such a pact, as are Korea, Australia and New Zealand, he said.

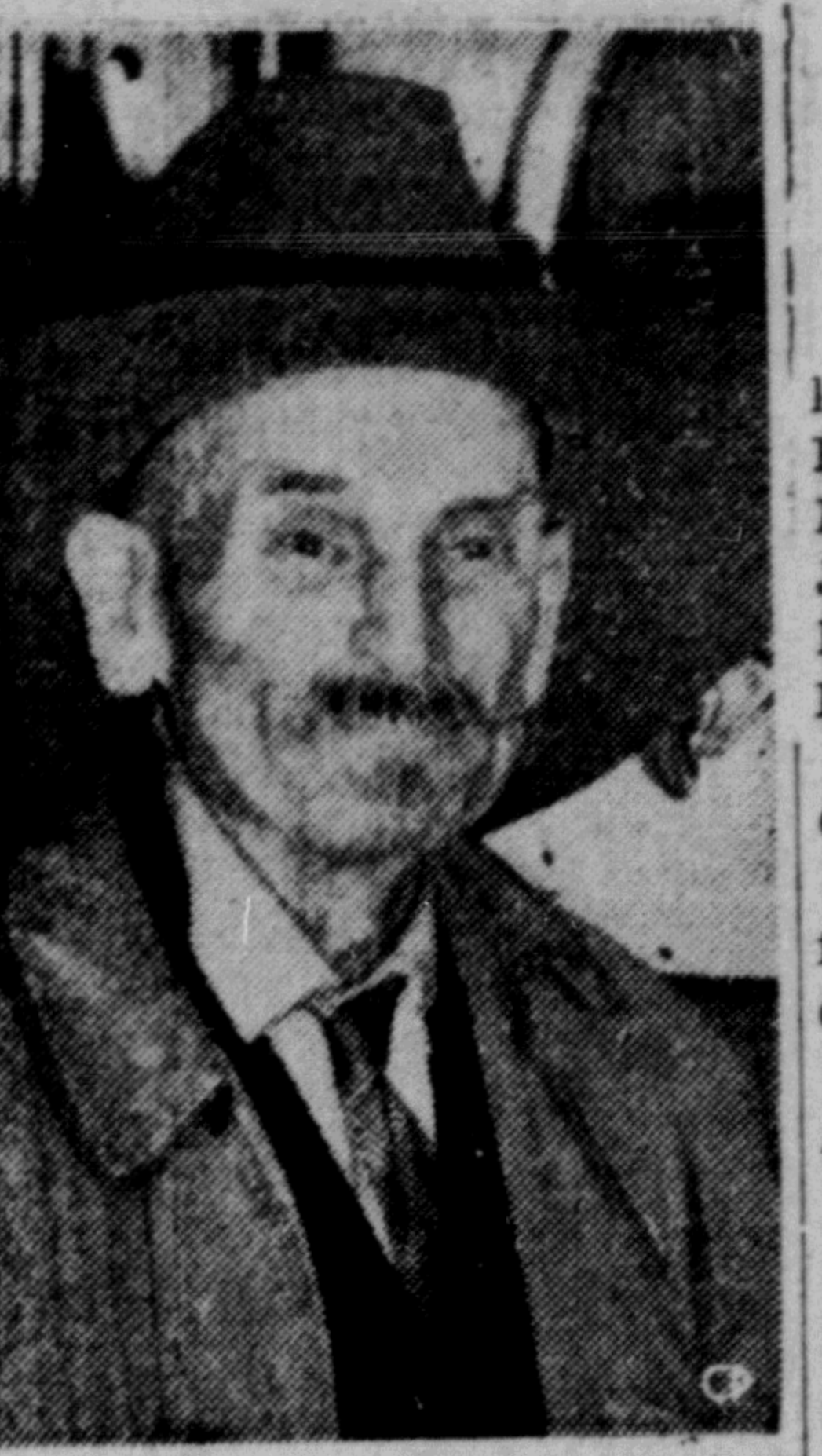
