The Bible, which Voltaire at the beginning of the Eighteenth Century had predicted would be were elected as follows: extinct in the world, was today in greater circulation than ever before and was a most import- ser. ant factor in holding together the fabric of civilization, declared J. A. Raymond Tingley of Vancouver, secretary for British Columbia of the British and Foreign Bible Society in one of the week-end addresses during a week-end visit to the city during a tour of the district.

Armies could not stop the aggression of communism and fascism, declared Mr. Tingley. Only a spiritual renaissance could do so.

It was not opposition that would kill the Church of Christianity, asserted the visiting pastor. Rather, it was indifference that would be fatal. Here in Prince Rupert real opposition might even be of benefit in spurring the Church itself.

Nevertheless, Mr. Tingley saw growing interest in the work of "the Church and the Bible" Society generally. He reported that the Bible was now in print; in 1090 different languages and there was a greater and greater demand from all parts of the world.

At a rally of various congregations last night in St. Paul's Lutheran Church Mr. Tingley gave an illustrated address entitled "At the Crossroads," a moving picture film proving of much interest.

Mr. Tingley pictured the urgent need of Bibles in Africa, China, Japan, India, Burma and most of the countries of Europe. He spoke of opened doors in Japan, where there is being born a hunger for the word of God greater than ever before. Germany, he said, is asking for 4 million Bibles and 6 million New Testaments.

The secretary portrayed the work of the Bible Society in translating the Scriptures into languages. He stated that in addition to translating and publishing the Scriptures, the Society distributes them. It also supplied all of the churches' with the Scriptures which their missionaries use in all lands.


