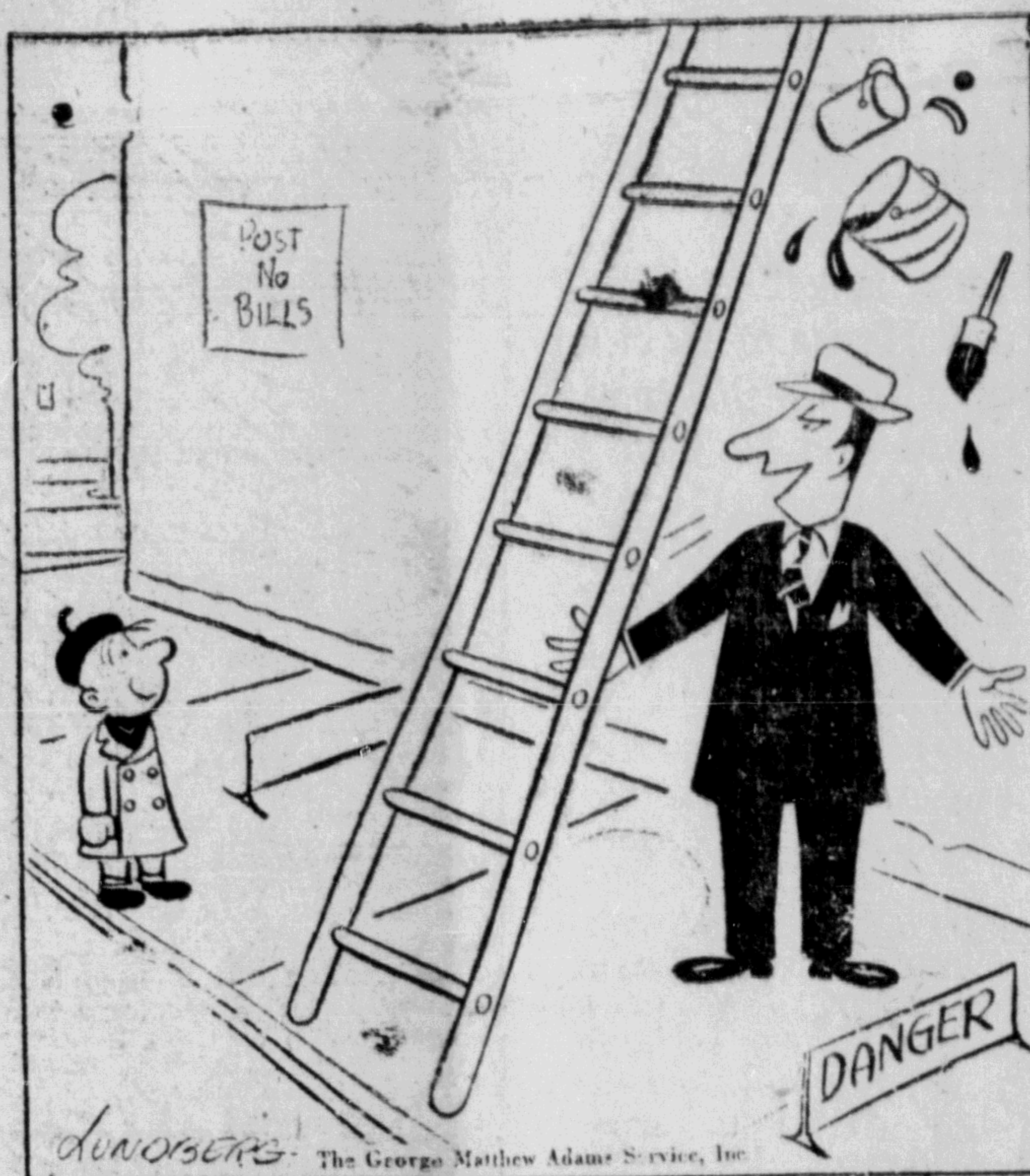

Massei Helps  
Marooned Man

MASSET—John Kresnevich, who was cast up on Graham Island after drifting across Dixon Entrance in his trolling boat and then hiked from the vicinity of North Island to be rescued from the other side of Masset Inlet after one of the most harrowing experiences that any man could have survived, was taken home to Ketchikan late last week by an Ellis Air Lines plane which came over to get him. Before he left for home, native people of Masset kindly to him, even gave a party of admiration in his honor at which an address was given by Chief Councillor George Jones. Mr. Kresnevich, while heading south from Ketchikan, started to drift on January 14 when the clutch of the engine in his trolling boat broke down at the entrance of Portland Inlet. He was washed up at midnight January 15 close to North Island. From there he hiked to the west side of Masset Inlet, paddling across Naden Harbor on an improvised raft. This journey took him five days in extremely low temperature. After three days on the far shore of Masset Inlet, the smoke of his fire was seen by Indian Superintendent J. A. Findlay and his rescue by the crew of the Masset Maid was effected. Kresnevich hopes to return here from Ketchikan within a few days with aid to get his boat off

## ROBIN HOOD BUTTERMILK SCONES

2 cups sifted Robin Hood Flour 4 tablespoons shortening  
½ teaspoon soda ¼ cup plus 2 tablespoons  
½ teaspoon salt buttermilk or sour milk

1. Sift together flour, baking soda and salt into mixing bowl. Cut shortening into small pieces and add to dry ingredients. Blend together until mixture is mealy, using pastry blender (or two knives, cutting in with scissor-like motion).  
2. Make a well in the center of mixture and gradually add the buttermilk or sour milk, stirring lightly with fork. Mix until just soft dough is formed.  
3. Turn out onto lightly floured bakboard or pastry cloth and divide in two equal portions. Gently roll out each piece with floured rolling pin or pat out with hand into circles ½ inch thick. Place circles on ungreased cookie sheet and cut in quarters, but do not separate the pieces. Bake at 450°F. (very hot oven) for 12 to 15 minutes. Makes 8 individual scones.
