THREE PLAYS

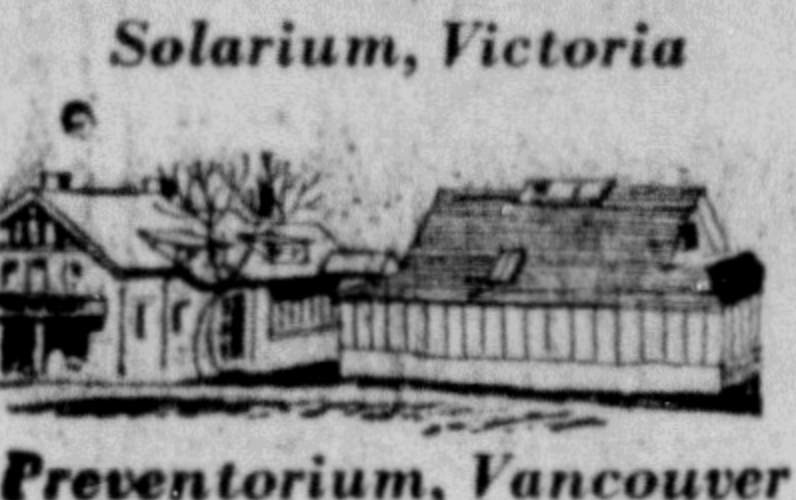
