#### Separate Shower Room no Luxury For Home With Sports Enthusiasts

"Do - it - yourself" enthusiasts who want to try out the new technique of staining unfinished furniture with fabric dyes should note the rules for doing the job right.

A home-economics bureau reports that dye-stains dissolved in water will successfully stain unpainted furniture. This makes it possible to use the 50 or more colors offered in the fabric dyes put out by various companies. However, there are some ifs, ands, and buts to note:

1. The color of the dye in water solution will look different on the wood. Be prepared to test and keep testing for the right color.

2. The dye solution must used fresh. It loses potency you let it stand around. prepared to stain the whole piece in one sitting.

3. Dye solutions from two identical boxes of dye won't always come out exactly the same. If you have a set of unpainted furniture to do, do it all at once to make sure the color matches. In doing the job. use this pro-

cedure: Dissolve the dye in water. (One box in a quart of water will do the average bookcase.) Brush it on or wipe it on with a cloth, but remember to
