threat of Rhee's hanging over
its head,
THE LOYAL members of the
UN showed in Korea that
they would support the U.S.A.
if she led in resistance to clear-
cut aggression. In the Sixteen
Nation Declaration, after the
end of fighting in Korea, they
also clearly stated that "We af-
firm, in the interests of world
peace, that if there is a renewal
of the armed attack, we should
again be united and prompt to
resist."

The "attack" referred to
above is of course another at-
tack from the North, by the
Communist forces. No one has
yet answered: Would UN crack
down on Rhee if he attacked?
