Sluff Loser on Loser; Direct Opponent's Lead

When your partner opens the bidding, he has Annis, 41, of Scarborough, Ont., better than an average hand in high cards. If you have as good as an average hand yourself, obviously your side has the balance of power.

When partner opens the bidding and second hand doubles, you flash this information by redoubling. This call does not necessarily guarantee your side will reach a game. However, it does guarantee that you will make another bid (or double). Partner can therefore pass on the second round if he is not sure what action to take, with s-7 full assurance that you will take some further action.
