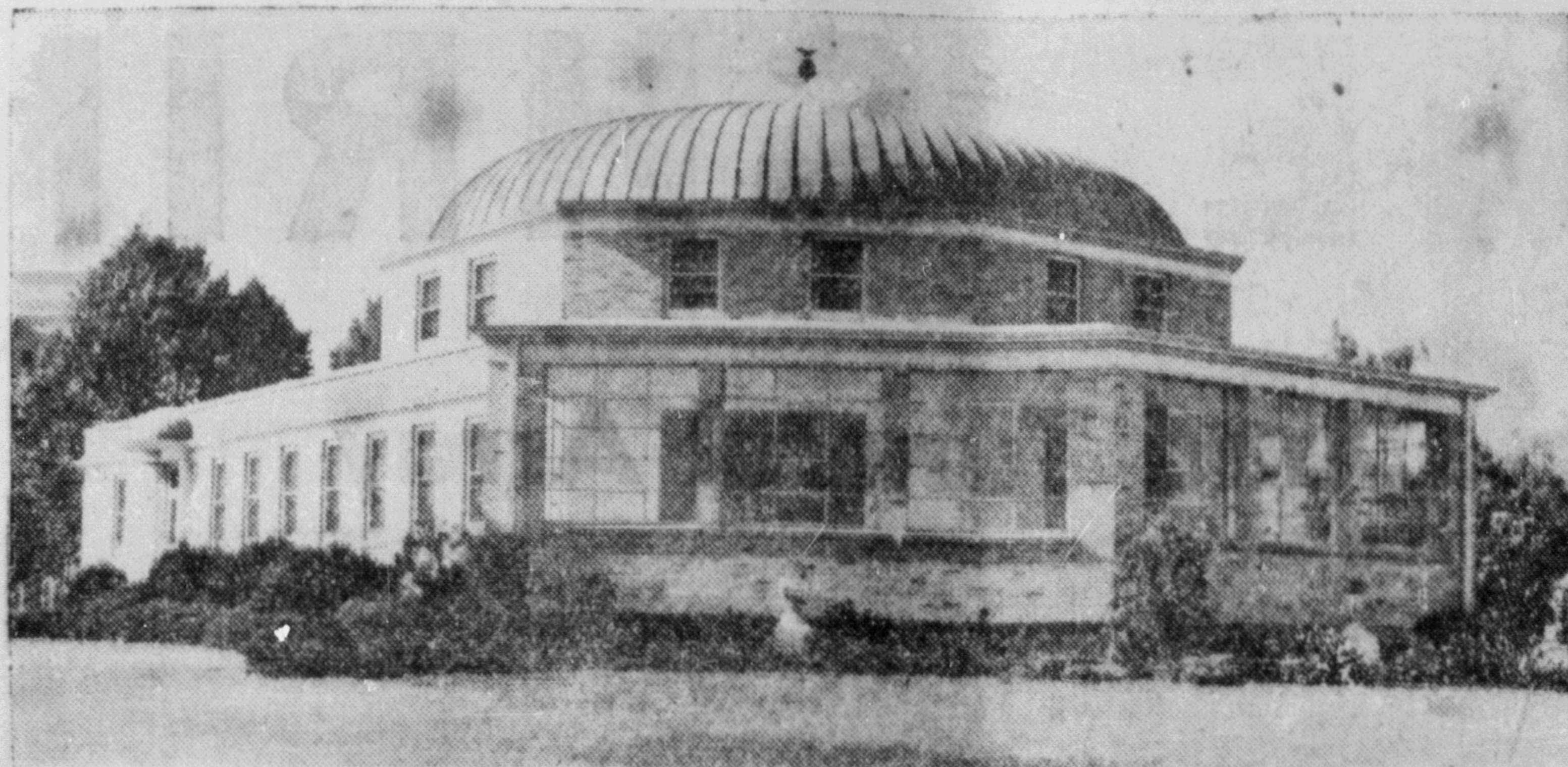

# Shriners Main Work — Care of Crippled Children

## Operate 16 Children's Hospitals

To manage even one hospital successfully is a highly technical and complex job. Yet, fun-loving Shriners of North America—for the care and treatment of indigent, crippled children—established 16, and at present have an exceptionally large one under construction in Los Angeles, California.

So successfully have they managed these hospitals, and with such whole-hearted enthusiasm have they supported their program, that many non-Shrine members have been influenced to donate millions of dollars to help the Shriners in their noble work.

The Shriners' Hospital movement for crippled children is one of the finest living examples that members of the Masonic

Order believe in God and His Teachings.

Due to the Shrine Hospital movement, over 200,000 children have been cured or helped, and attention of the nation became focussed on the problem of its handicapped children . . . its citizens of tomorrow.

This, surely, is evidence that there was a Divine Spirit guiding Shriner W. Freeland Kendrick when, back in 1920, he proposed the Shriners' Hospital movement for crippled children. This, surely, confirms our belief that the Divine Spirit has watched our progress through the intervening years and has blessed what we are doing on behalf of the crippled children of our land. Shriners' Hospitals are accept-

ing crippled children under the age of 14 years who have no mental ailment and whose parents are unable to pay. This does not necessarily mean that the parents must be paupers. The father may have a modest, or even a substantial income, but he may also have a large number of dependents. The cost of treatment for his crippled child, as a private case, might run so high as to be prohibitive. Under such circumstances the child would be admitted.

There is no bar to color or creed for admittance. The Shriners know that every child is God's child and be he black, white or yellow, or whatever religious belief he may be, it is all the same. He is a child to heal.

## Little League Baseball

The Shriners of Gizeh Temple do not confine their efforts entirely to the Shriners' Crippled Children's Hospitals. They donate large sums of money and other gifts to the Preventorium, the Vancouver Children's Hospital, Queen Alexandra Solarium, and to other worth while causes. They have also sponsored a team in the Little League Baseball Team.

Little League baseball is played under the same rules that the major leagues play under and only boys who are under the age of 14 are allowed to participate.

Little League Baseball has been responsible for instilling in the younger boys the spirit of comradeship and fair play.

The boys of the Shrine team travelled to United States last year to play in an international play-off and it is hoped the

Shrine team this year will be picked to play in the play-off at Williamsport, Penn.
