

Later converted to steam, the 245-foot warship sailed the world's seas until 1875, when she was moved to the river Mersey to become the base of the British merchant marine's training-

During the Second World War air raids the Conway was towed away from the target city of Liverpool to safer moorings, off the Welsh coast. The aged vessel was still a training centre for 250 youths when her death blow struck unexpectedly last spring.






