Home economists point out that skim milk powder may be used in every way that fresh milk . used. As a general rule, it is best to use four tablespoons (one ounce) of skim milk powder and one cup of water in place of one cup of fresh milk. For extra food value, there is an advantage in using more than this amount of skim milk powder or in adding some to such foods as cooked breakfast cereals, meat loaves or gravies which are not usually made with milk. However, it is not wise to increase the amount of skim milk powder to the point where palatability is affected.






