In fishing for tuna, they said on the end of an unweighed 80foot line is placed a double. barbless, stainless steel hook hidden in a bundle of red and white chicken feathers, or per-17 lines out.

Excitement causes the tuna's 70 and 80 degrees. If iced immediately not only will the ice melt quickly but the fish will split up the back. They have to be left on deck under wet socks for two hours before icing.
