## Angel Saves Victoria Team

VICTORIA (CP)—An "angel" has appeared to rescue the Victoria team from their financial woes. The Victoria Times in a front-page story announced that the Western International league baseball club's benefactor, Robert Hew Fergusson-Pollock, has offered to subscribe up to \$50,000 share capital in the club.

Mr. Fergusson-Pollock and his wife, Laura, are owners of a large baronial estate at Hyattsville, two miles north of Cowan Bay, and heirs to an old-money estate, including a castle, the Times says.

Mr. Fergusson-Pollock was reported planning to dispose of his English estate so that he would be in a position to help the local club. Both he and his wife are great Tyee fans. "I know it can be arranged," he said. "I am willing to put \$50,000 into the club."

Mr. Fergusson-Pollock, who came to Canada from England in 1910, has no thought of returning. The castle has been in his family since 1929.
