Consommé Salad is Star at Summer Meals
 STAR performers at your summer meals are the cool, jewel-like gelatin salads. For the richest flavored salads, start with condensed consommé as the base.
 A can of this meaty broth, which contains gelatin, is a natural for these jellied specialties. Just add chopped meat and vegetables to consommé (along with more gelatin); and let the refrigerator take over. One bite. Then you know how good a salad can taste.
 A basic recipe for consommé salad can be made with either chopped chicken or tongue. Both a joy to eat. Try one, then the other. You're sure of two delightful summer suppers.
Jellied Consommé Tongue Salad
 1 envelope unflavored gelatin
 1 cup cold water
 1 can (1 1/2 cups) condensed consommé
 2 to 4 tablespoons lemon juice
 1/2 cup diced tongue (smoked, canned, or cured)
 1/2 cup minced cucumber
 2 tablespoons sliced, stuffed olives
 1 hard-boiled egg, chopped
 Soften gelatin in cold water; then set container of gelatin in pan of boiling water until gelatin is dissolved. Combine gelatin, consommé and lemon juice; chill until mixture begins to thicken. Fold in remaining ingredients. Place a 3-quart mold or loaf pan with cold water (for decoration, arrange through the iron curtain became a day and night flood.

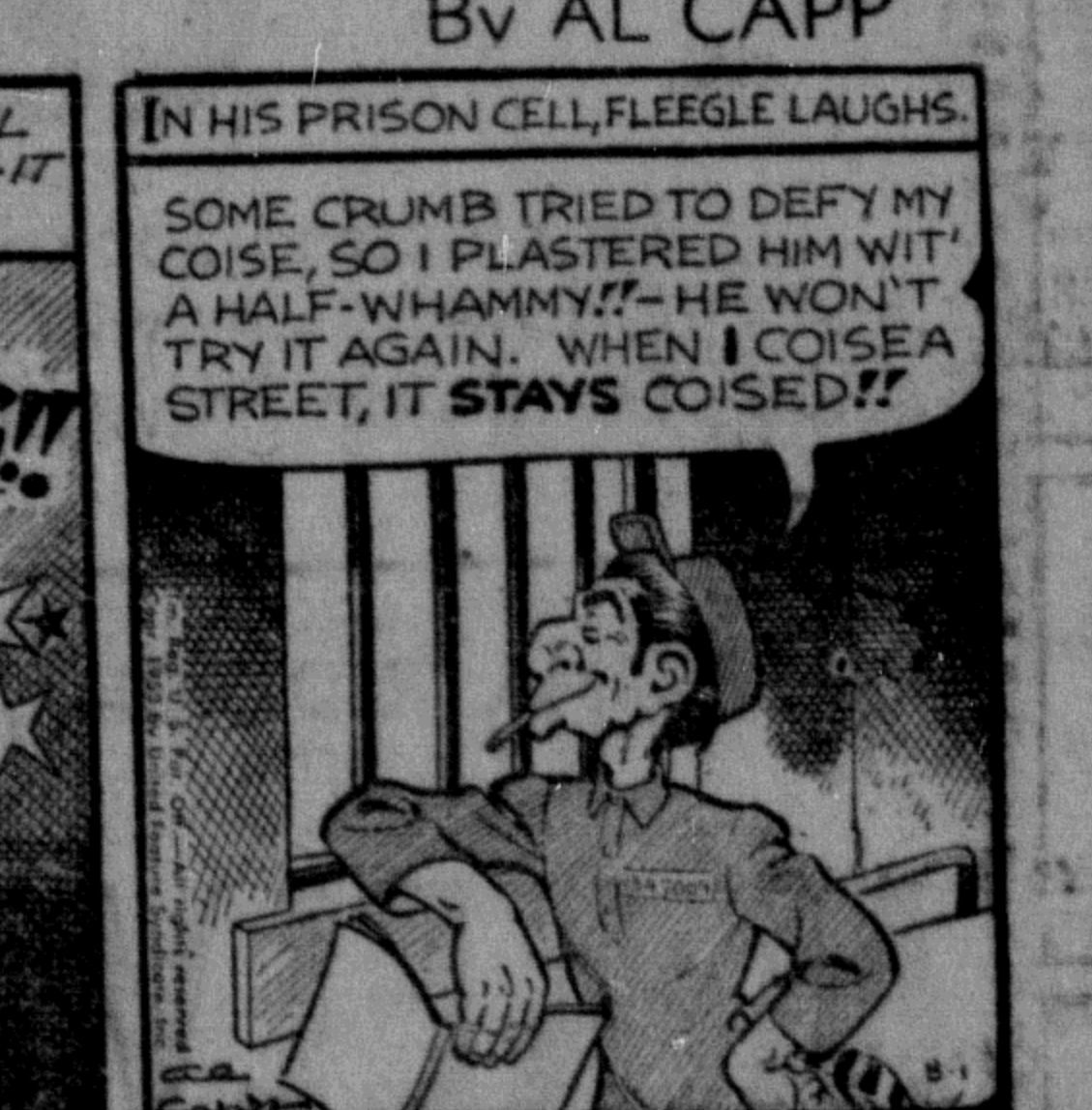
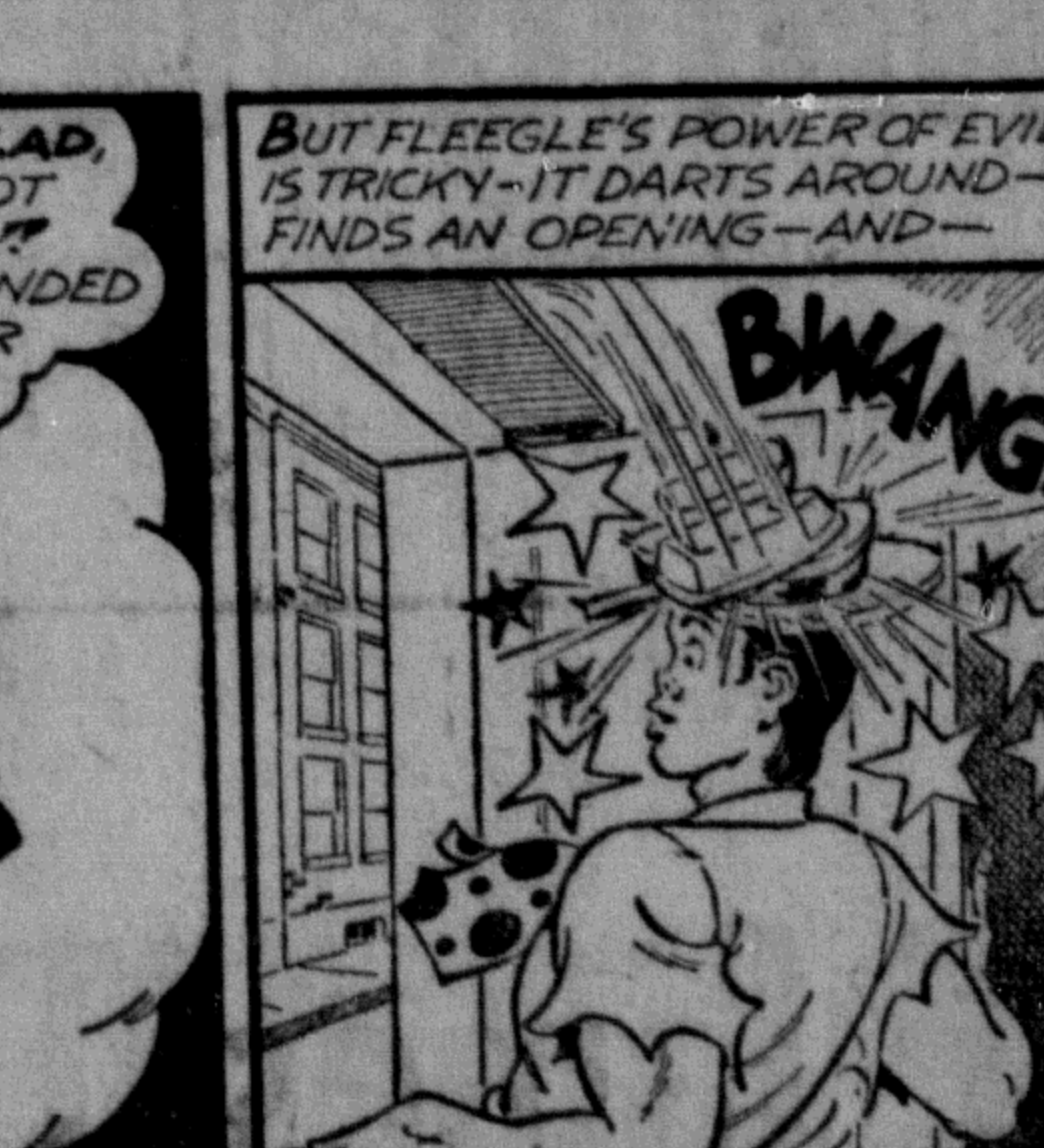
