### No Excuse for Failure To Use Easy Safety Plays

Some safety plays are so simple to execute and so easy to see that failure to make them can be attributed only to laziness.

In today's deal, for example, the sound no trump slam was makeable by means of a type of play which comes up very frequently. Mr. Meek led the jack of diamonds even though Mr. Muzzy had bid that suit. This lead made it very probable that the diamonds would not break 3-3. Mr. Muzzy saw that he had nine top honors outside the spade suit. Therefore, if he could take three spade tricks he would be home.

He started off right by winning the first trick in his own hand and leading a small spade. Mr. Meek ducked and dummy's jack won. Surely, if Mrs. Keen had held the ace of spades she would have won this trick. The reason is that it would have been her best play and she is a good player.

But Mr. Muzzy now led back a small spade and put up his king, losing to the ace. After this gruesome play he either had to lose a diamond to Mr. Meek or a spade to Mrs. Keen. "Playing give-away again, Muzzy?" sneered Mr. Champion. "You led up to my spades once and the jack held. Why not go back to your hand and lead another low spade? Meek would have had to play the ace and then you could have played the seven from the board. My queen and your king would then take the 11th and 12th tricks for you."

"How could I tell Meek had exactly the ace and one other spade?" said Mr. Muzzy.

"You couldn't," yelled Mr. Champion. "And I'm not asking you to, I'm merely asking you to play the hand so that if he does have that holding, you will make your bid."

Mr. Champion was right. After it appeared that the ace of spades was on his left, Mr. Muzzy should have re-entered his hand in one of the other suits and led a second spade. If Mr. Meek had started with only two spades, his play of the ace here would guarantee 12 tricks for Mr. Muzzy. If Mr. Meek had started with three spades to the ace, the suit would break 3-3 and again the contract would be cold.

Mr. Champion's suggested play had everything to gain and nothing to lose. Mr. Muzzy's play, on the other hand, could not win.

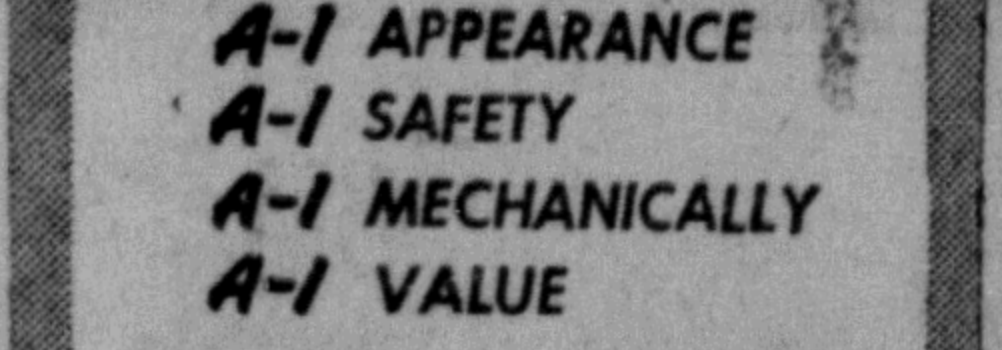
