## China Makes Gains Under Red Rule

HONG KONG (AP) - After four years under Communist rule, China has made gains. From evidence available, these appear to be the biggest Red improvements in China:

The army. It is the best China ever had. It is also a whopper. Communist China's field armies are believed to include well over 2,000,000 men. Add the Red militia and you have a possible Red Chinese army of 10,000,000.

Flood control, The Reas claim they have set up great reclamation projects to hold back flood waters. Red China still has floods but they have been small ones in the last two years.

Railroads. The reds are known to have rebuilt old rail lines and laid some new ones. New markets have been opened for farmers and for factory products. All in all, the Reds claim they have reconstructed 3,000 miles of rail lines.

Outside these three fields. Red claims of improvement meet with skepticism, even among neutral observers.

China has had good crops for the last three years. But this apparently came about largely because of good weather and internal peace rather than and redistribution, as the Communists


