## Conductors Agree On Wage Boost

MONTREAL — A joint statement issued here by the Order of Railway Conductors and the Canadian National Railways announced signing Wednesday of new wage agreements calling for an 11 per cent increase in basic rates of pay with no rule changes.

The agreements, which are effective until June 25, 1953, cover more than 1800 Canadian National conductors on the western, central and Atlantic regions of the railway excluding Newfoundland district. The wage increase is retroactive to May 16, 1952.

## Korean War Burns With New Glow

TOKYO (AP) — The twilight war in Korea is beginning to burn with a bright new glow. Unless an armistice is agreed to soon, military observers feel certain full-scale fighting will break out again all along the line.

There are two reasons for the assumption:

1. The recent 500-plane armada attack on the North Korean hydro-electric plants is a warning to the Reds that unless they start talking soon, they can expect more of the same.

2. Both sides are fighting for ground now and the scrap west of Choswon is for positions which the Reds won and the U.S. Eighth Army had to go after with real force to get back.

The smashing air attack left no doubt but that the United Nations is through pussy-footing.

Asked if Gen. Mark Clark would be making a statement regarding the change of policy which permitted the raid, an officer at his UN Far East headquarters said:

"Those dams and installations were military targets in North Korea. No statement is necessary."

Asked if there would be an explanation as to why they were bombed now, after pilots had been warned for months to leave them alone, he replied:

"You'll have to draw your own conclusion and it shouldn't be very hard to draw."

The natural conclusion is that after two years of flying around the big dams on the Yalu, the Far Eastern Air Force finally got orders to knock out the power plants because the UN Command decided it was time to get tough.

"Now wait," snapped Mr. Muzzy. "Don't throw exceptions at me. I don't even know the rule yet."

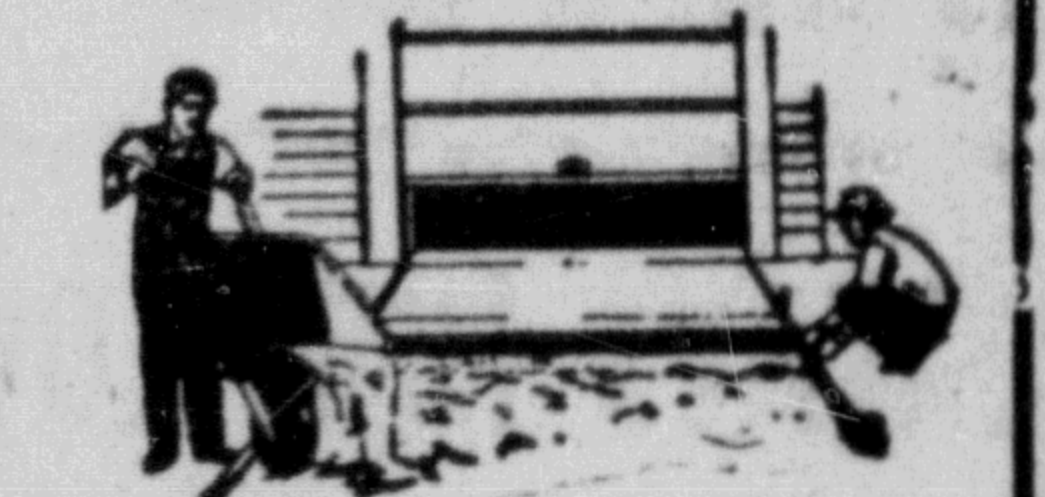
This forthright remark brought down the house. "There is nothing you can say to top that, Mr. Heinsite," remarked Miss Brash. "You have definitely lost the argument."
