## Reds Tighten Defences in Truce Area

Canadian Press Staff Writer PANMUNJOM, Korea -The Communists have tightened a menacing ring of trenches, bunkers, barbed wire and guns around almost all the Panmunjom neutral truce

From this frozen patch of attack-free ground between the opposing armies you can see an ntricate system of deep Communist trenches, at some places less than 30 yards from the neutral border line. There remains only a corridor on the Allied side, through which United Nations personnel may pass.

Truce talks broke down here command the Reds maintain only small security and service detachments within the 1,000yard-radius circle.

The Allied command, replying to a Red protest, admitted an accidental shelling of the armistice site, but protested in turn that the Communists inup machine-guns and other weapons immediately adjacent' to the circle and "the United Nations is compelled, in selfdefence, to direct artillery fire against these positions."

I received a cold, menacing welcome from the Reds inside the circle, and noted many

Outside the neutral border Chinese held a burp gun pointed toward the circle.

NO RESTRICTIONS

There are no restrictions forbidding the Reds to take posi tions around the circle, but they must remain outside.


## Co-Operation . Housing Field

#### CP, CN Charge Higher Fares Than PGE

transport commissioners was told Tuesday that passenger fares charged in British Columbia by Canada's two major railroads are lower than those of the B.C.-owned Pacific Great Eastern Railway.

Figures of comparison were introduced by the Canadian Pacific and Canadian National Railways at the hearing on B.C.'s application for removal of the mountain differential on passenger fares.

First-class fares are based on a 41/2-cent-a-mile rate in B.C. compared to PGE charges of 4.6 cents a mile with no distinction between first class and coach whereas they charge 4.5 cents for first class and four cents for

The PGE is owned entirely by the provincial government.

Earlier counsel for the CPR admitted passengers riding major railroads in B.C. do pay more for tickets than those in the rest of
