Private Bill Seeks Change In Legislation

OTTAWA (CP)-Senator G. H. Ross (L-Alberta) appealed in the Senate for support of private bill that would make it possible to collect damages in legal actions from Indians. He said present legislation makes it impossible to collect damages from Indians when the courts find them liable. The law originally was intended to protect Indians from unscrupulous non-Indians, but was out-

dated. He said Indians should be treated as others if the courts find them liable for proper damages. Senator Wishart Robertson,

government leader, adjourned debate on the bill sponsored by Senator Ross.
