Fletcher Robbe's double in the ninth drove in catcher Jim Gladd with the winning run as Portland trimmed Sacramento, 4-3. Bob Alexander was the winning pitcher. I Cicotte the loser.

Ted Beard homered for San Francisco in the ninth but it wasn't enough and Oakland beat the Seals, 3-2. Ken Holcombe went the distance for San Francisco, allowing only five hits, while Chuck Beamon retired as Oakland's starter in favor of Bob Murray.

Bill Thomason limited Seattle to one hit, a single in the first inning by George Schmees that scored a run, as San Diego beat the Rainiers, 5-1.

Bombers Sign Evan Slonac

WINNIPEG — Ralph Misenar, president of the Winnipeg Blue Bombers, announced today the signing of halfback Evan Slonac, former star with Michigan State Spartans.

The 23-year-old, 170-pound Slonac becomes the 15th import to sign with the Western Inter-provincial Football Union club. Thirteen Canadians also have been signed for 1954.

Slonac, who played on the Michigan varsity team from 1931 to 1953, was a member of the Spartans famed "pony backfield," consisting of quarterback Tom Yewick and halves Leroy Bolden and Billy Wells, none of whom weighed more than 180 pounds.

Last year, Slonac averaged 5.3 yards rushing on 71 tries. He scored two touchdowns and converted 16 of 18 attempts in eight games.

Tug Owners Plan Service

VANCOUVER — Plans for a tug-boat rescue service on the jagged British Columbia coast were completed here by the B.C. Tugboat Owners' Association last night.

A heavy toll of life and property from blizzards and gales last winter led to organization of the rescue unit which will serve almost 300 operators and 1,500 men.

The unit, to be paid for by the operators, will act as the marine arm of the RCAF search and rescue centre.

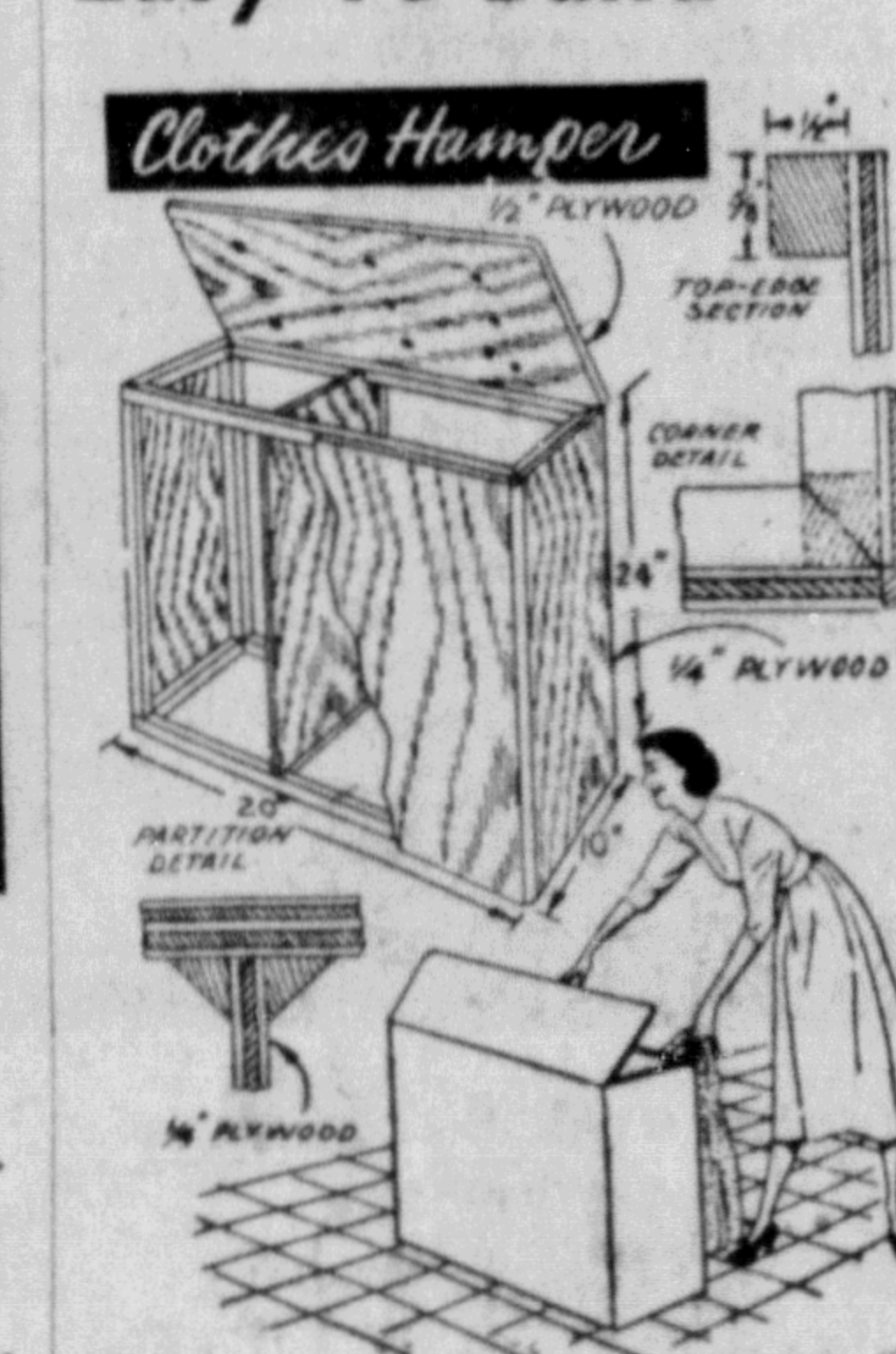

**Plywood Hamper
Easy To Build**



No washday aid, perhaps, is of more use throughout the rest of the week than the clothes hamper.

Simple as a box, convenient as a third hand, the easy-to-build Douglas fir plywood hamper shown here fits neatly into either the bathroom or utility area.

Front and side panels are of 1/2 inch fir plywood. Holes for air should be spaced in the 1/2 inch hinged top. Bottom should be of heavier 3/4 inch plywood to give stability.

The frame of 3/8 x 1/2 inch strips can be assembled with and nails (or use screws). The panels and quarter-round corners are similarly attached. The partition of the fir plywood hamper can be installed using small, triangular strips to hold it in place.
