## Pulp Output Seen by Mid-'54

SEATTLE (AP)-The Ketchikan Pulp Co., a \$46.000.000 venture of the Puget Sound Pulp and Timber Co. and American Viscose Corp., probably will be producing pulp from Alaska's Tongass National Forest before mid-1954, a report to stockholders discloses.

In its report, Puget Sound Pulp of Bellingham said progress in erecting the mill and in other phases of the project has been such that production can be expected before June 1.

The report said construction of the mill buildings at Ward Cove, 71/2 miles north of Ketchikan on Tongass Narrows, now is almost complete.

Ketchikan Pulp has started accumulation of a log inventory with which to start production. The Ketchikan plant will make the beginning of wood pulp industry in Alaska.


