

Mr. Champion won with the eight and returned the ten of spades. Miss Brash could now afford to finesse the queen. It lost and a spade came back. She won with the ace and finessed the queen of clubs. When this held and clubs broke 3-3, a spade was discarded from dummy on the 13th club.
