BLACKWOOD on BRIDGE

Dale Makes Decision, Drives Home on Trick Two

This is one of those touchy hands which seem to occur much too often and in which an important decision has to be made at the very first trick.

Mr. Champion led the five of hearts and Mr. Dale had to make up his mind whether to hold off or to win. If the diamond finesse was right, nine tricks were immediately available—six diamonds, two hearts and a club.

But if Mr. Dale held the king of diamonds, there were only five tricks in that suit and a spade trick would have to be picked up to make the required nine. In this latter case, the hold-up at trick one seemed to be called for.

However, there was another point to consider. If the defenders were permitted to hold the first trick, what if they shifted to clubs—a suit in which Mr. Dale had just one stopper? Then the diamond finesse would have to be right.

Mr. Dale realized that he might go set no matter how he played. But if the hand was hard to play, it was also hard to defend. In view of the danger of a club shift he elected to forget about the hold-up and to put the defenders on the spot at trick two.

Accordingly, he won with the ace of hearts and led a spade from the board. It should have been clear to Mr. Abel that the old master was trying to steal a spade trick, else why was he ignoring the long diamond suit in dummy?

Apparently it wasn't clear, for Mr. Abel played low. Mr. Dale won with the king of spades and shifted to the 10 of diamonds, which was ducked in dummy. With one spade trick home he didn't care now whether the finesse worked or not as he had nine sure winners.
