## Brooks Defeat Cubs With Base Stealing

NEW YORK.—Brooklyn and New York Giants are pulling away from the rest of the National League in a determined effort to make a two-team race of it as Chicago Cubs appear to have shot their bolt.

Dodgers took their second night from Chicago yesterday, winning 6-5 in a ten-inning decision to hand Cubs their fourth consecutive defeat, the season high for the Windy City outfit. Giants whipped Pittsburgh 5-2 to remain four games back of the pace-setting Dodgers. Increase their lead over second-place Bruins to 2½ games. Brooks contrived their winning without the aid of a hit as they snapped the 5-5 deadlock in the tenth.

Jackie Robinson led off by making a pass from Dutch Leonard. He promptly stole second for the third time and raced to third when catcher Toby Atwell dropped a knuckleball third strike to Campanella, which permitted the batter to reach first.

## Canadians To Try for World Rowing Honors

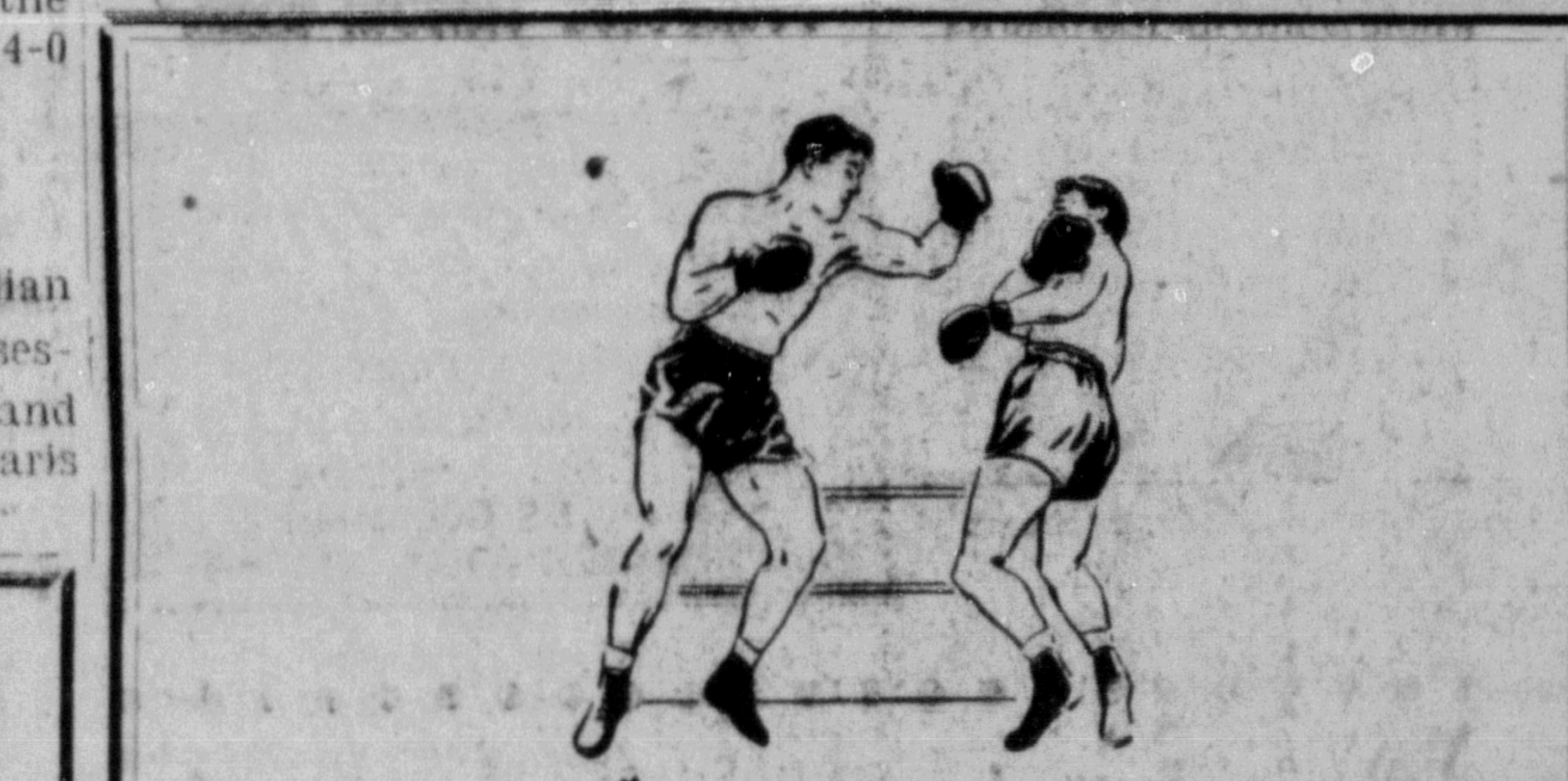

TORONTO.—The crew that will represent Canada in the six-metre class yacht races at the Olympic games next month in Helsinki, Finland, left here by air Monday for Stockholm, Sweden, and a rendezvous with the Trickson.

The sleek, sea-green craft was purchased for Canada by Toronto mining executive Bryan W. Newkirk just 48 hours before the Finns tried to buy it. The five-man crew with a spare man from the Royal Canadian Yacht Club will arrive in Stockholm Wednesday. For the next two weeks, skipper Bill Gooderham, 33, and his men will familiarize themselves with the Swedish-built boat under the eye of its former owner.

Other members of the crew are Ken Bradfield, 23-year-old main-sheet man, Bill Copeland, 23, and Bill Macintosh, 21, both on the jib sheet and mainstay, and Don Tytler, 28, on the light canvas or spinnaker. Rowan MacDonald, 26, is spare man. The silver-like Trickson, about 36 feet long with a six-foot beam, is considered by yachtsmen to be one of the fastest six-metres in the world. She has won every major race she entered, including the Scandinavian Gold Cup in 1950 when she beat the Lian-cra, winner of the six-metre for the United States in the 1948 Olympics.

Gooderham and his crew will sail the Trickson from Stockholm to Helsinki, about 450 miles and a week's sailing, for the games.

**FIRST TIME**  
This is the first time Canada has been represented in the Olympic six-metres and the first year all the crew members out Bradfield have sailed that class of boat. Gooderham, whose sailing background goes back through his father and grandfather almost to the first days of the (Continued on page 8)
