**SPORTS ROUND-UP**

NEW YORK (AP)—Anyone for boxing? If so, it is our privilege to turn you over to Murray Goodman, the redoubtable publicist of the International Boxing Club, for a mid-summer refresher course on the present state of the manly art.

"In the first place," began Goodman, "there is this raise in the main eventers will get starting September 15. After that when a fight is on the TV cable each main eventer will draw \$4,000 of TV money in addition to his purse. Just as the picture goes out of the state, that is.

"That's one thing. Another is that Rocky Marciano and Roland Lasterza start boxing Saturday for their fight Sept. 24 at the Polo Grounds. By the way, that will be the first heavyweight championship between two white boys in 18 years, since Jimmy Braddock won the title from Max Baer.

"I've just been two days with Marciano and I want to tell you he isn't taking this thing lightly. He told me this might be his toughest fight. The way Rocky looks at it, Lasterza is younger than he is and is a hell of a boxer. He figures Lasterza is bound to have improved since he fought him three years ago. Rocky is a smart boy.

"The next challenger probably will come out of the fight between Ezzard Charles and Harold Johnson Sept. 8 at Philadelphia. However, if Lasterza wins, you can't tell. He's a boxer, not a puncher, and everybody will want a crack at him, including Archie Moore, the light-heavy champ.

"The best chance for a lot of action this fall and winter is in the middleweight division. Besides Bobo Olson and Randy Turpin, who will fight either here or in San Francisco for the vacant championship, there are four or five other real good middleweights.

Next comes the welterweights, and nobody knows what Kid Gavilan intends to do about defending. It'll be a crime, though, if he doesn't give Johnny Bratton of Chicago a title shot. Only thing is, Gavilan might decide to go into the

middleweights. "It never fails. When a fighter wins one division he wants to go up one."

**Beavers Win Game of Year**

Portland has won the baseball game of the year, a 22-inning thriller at San Francisco Wednesday in which the Seals finally bowed, 4-2, after 4 hours, 30 minutes of toil.

It was the longest game in the Pacific Coast League since May 6, 1928, when Oakland beat Sacramento, 7-6, in 22 innings. The league record is 24 innings to a 1-1 tie, Sept. 10, 1911, between Portland and Sacramento, and San Francisco's 1-0 win over Oakland, June 8, 1909.

But in those gaslight contests the starting pitchers finished. Wednesday, three hurlers worked for Portland, four for San Francisco. Larry Ward, who came in for Portland in the 20th, was credited with the victory, and Ted Shandor, who took over for the Seals in the 20th, was the loser.

Frank Austin's single, Hank Artt's walk, Fletcher Robbe's single, and still another single by Bob Marous ended the round-trip in the 22nd inning.

Portland's victory put the Beavers within one game of the Seals, who, by winning Tuesday's doubleheader, took over undisputed occupancy of fourth place. Portland has held fourth place most of the season.

Seattle nudged Los Angeles in 10 innings, 8-7.

Hollywood made it three straight over Sacramento, 4-3, as Dale Long hit his 25th homer in the eighth inning.

San Diego shoved Oakland into sole possession of the cellar by taking a doubleheader from the Acorns, 6-3 and 5-2.
