Mr. Truex Looks Good In This Bridge Bout

This hand, played in an actual tournament, will give you an idea of the ability of Mr. Truex, the real, live champion and tournament winner. He looked good on this one but in following columns I want to show you some gruesome results which he suffered. It may encourage you to see how even the best slip now and then.

In today's deal Mr. Truex found himself playing two hearts, doubled, when Mr. Abel made the doubtful decision to leave in his partner's takeout double.

The nine of spades was opened and Mr. Dale won with the ace and returned the five. Truex was pleasantly surprised when his king was not trumped. He had two losers in clubs and the same in diamonds. Surely Mr. Abel had three hearts to the queen so that there was a total of six apparent losers.

After a little thought Mr. Truex led the 10 of hearts at trick

three. Mr. Abel almost went wrong on this one, but finally came up with the queen and returned a small club. Dummy's ace won and a spade was led and ruffed high in the closed hand.

A small heart was led and Mr. Truex finessed the seven spot on the board. When this held, another spade was led and ruffed high, killing Mr. Dale's queen. Next, another small heart was led to dummy's nine, picking up Mr. Abel's last trump.

Dummy's good spade was led and a losing diamond discarded from the closed hand. Thus the defenders were held to five tricks and the doubled contract was made.

Of course if Mr. Abel had elected to bid three diamonds instead of passing Mr. Dale's takeout double he would have had no trouble making at least four-odd. Or if he had opened a club instead of a spade, the story would have been different. Few, however, would have made that opening. By the same token few would have given up the first heart trick to create entries to the dummy, as Mr. Truex did.

Moscow Like Another World, Student Says

Six months ago, three young American student editors asked Moscow for visas to visit the Soviet Union. To their amazement, they were granted. In September, Mark Emmond of the University of Colorado; Daniel Berger of Oberlin College; and 22-year-old Zander Hollander of the University of Michigan flew off for two weeks in Russia. Here is Hollander's story of what he saw.

NEW YORK (AP)—An American in Russia feels he's in another world.

In the two weeks I spent there, I was never allowed to forget the Iron Curtain.

We toured Moscow's busy, wide streets frequently. Leaving the Hotel National, I noticed the frowning MVD militia men stationed around the clock at the door. We were not followed in our rubber-necking tours, but MVD men showed up often. They wore long, heavy blue overcoats with red epaulets, and pistols were visible on their hips.

Once, at a state-owned market off Gorki Street, I took a picture of a crowd of Muscovites elbowing determinedly for a chance to buy scarce Ukrainian melons. Seconds later, an MVD man showed up, asked to see our passports, said we couldn't take pictures. We argued that the tourist bureau had given us permission. He finally checked and came back to apologize. The crowd seemed to marvel that we got away with it.

TEDIOUS PROCEDURE

From what I could see, Muscovites spend many non-working hours waiting in line. Just for the experience, I queued up with them for bread, cheese, which was tasty, and candy, which was rubbery. For each of the three items, I had to line up three times.

First, you line up to find out what they're selling and for how much. Then you line up to get a purchase ticket from the cashier. That's when you pay. Then you get in a third line to get what you just paid for.

After dark, I saw many Russians return to slum homes, hidden behind an ill-kept facade of massive buildings. I looked into lighted windows on people living four or five to one dreary room.
