

UN Denies Patrols Sent Into Red Area

PANMUNJOM, Korea, (Reuters)—The United Nations command today rejected Communist charges that it had sent two armed patrols into Communist territory in Korea "to commit hostile acts."
Maj-Gen. J. K. Lacey, chief UN delegate to the military armistice commission, told the Communists there was "insufficient evidence" to support their charges that "armed attacks" on Saturday night and Sunday were carried out by UN troops.
Lacey offered a further investigation if the Communists would give more information.
