Green Player Needs Boost From Partner
 It is easy enough to criticize your partner for failure to make the right defensive play or lead. But sometimes the opportunity arises for you to guide him into the winning path.

That is one of the strong points of Mr. Dale's game. He is always alert to the possibility of making things easy for his partner, particularly partners of limited skill. In today's deal he "forced" Mr. New into making the right play.

On the bidding, it seemed certain that either the ace or queen of spades was on his left and therefore it was highly improbable that he could win to straight spade tricks. He decided to try to get in a ruff of a diamond. Accordingly, he laid down the ace of diamonds and shifted to the six of clubs.

Mr. Champion saw the danger of a diamond ruff and his problem, of course, was to keep Mr. New out of the lead. His plan was to win the ace of clubs, lead the ace of hearts and discard a club, then lead the jack of hearts and hope Mr. New would not cover it. In this case he would simply discard his last club and Mr. Dale would be in the lead again, with no way to reach his partner's hand.

It may be said that this plan had considerable chance of succeeding. Mr. New is much better as a kibitzer than a player. On the first lead of hearts it would be clear to him that his partner had the king of the suit and necessity of his covering the jack might not occur to him.

Mr. Dale took care of that. When the ace of hearts was led at trick three, he played the king. Now when the jack of hearts was led, it was obvious to Mr. New that he had to play his queen.

That did it. Mr. Champion ruffed and led the queen of spades. Mr. Dale covered and the ace won. A spade was returned to the ten and Mr. Dale won with the jack. He then led a club to his partner's king and ruffed the diamond return for the setting trick.

Mr. New didn't ever know he'd "helped." "Careful, partner," he said. "What did you do - pull the wrong card on that first heart lead?"

"Well, it was a lucky error, anyway," smiled Mr. Dale. "It didn't cost us a trick."

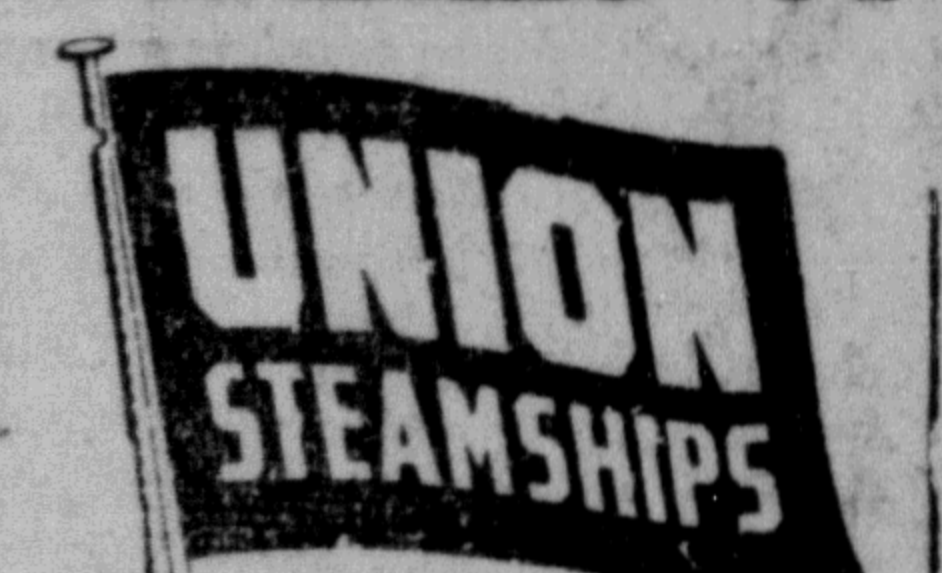
