Muzzy's Unorthodoxy Baffles the Experts

There are several reasons why Mr. Muzzy wins now and then. Sometimes he holds practically all of the high cards. Sometimes it is because of what we may loosely refer to as his "style."

Often a serious and scientific player will not do as well against Mr. Muzzy as he would against another expert. In other words, he may well be thrown off balance by Mr. Muzzy's unorthodox bids and plays.

In today's deal Mr. Muzzy led the seven of diamonds against the three no trump contract. Mr. Heinsite went into one of the year's longest huddles before playing from dummy. Of course, there is no question about his being "scientific," especially when he is telling someone else how they should have played a hand.

By the rule of 11 he figured Mrs. Keen had only one diamond higher than the seven. He also figured Mr. Muzzy had six diamonds for his over-call and therefore Mrs. Keen had two. As you see, he was right on both counts.

But that wasn't enough. He also had to know whether Mrs. Keen held the king or queen of diamonds. If she had neither, then the play was to duck in dummy and let the first trick run around to the jack.

If she held the king doubleton

Rupert Man Among Troops Coming Home

OTTAWA—The last homecoming contingent from Europe to complete the rotation of the 27th Canadian Infantry Brigade arrived in Halifax yesterday aboard the SS Atlantic.

Included are more than 300 members of the 58th Independent Field Squadron of the Royal Canadian Engineers, and other Canadian Army personnel. Also disembarking from the Atlantic were 64 wives and 33 children of Canadian soldiers who have either married in Europe or lived there while their husbands served with the brigade.

Among the soldiers was A/Cpl. P. R. Lindsay of the 58th Independent Field Squadron, whose wife lives at 241 Fifth Avenue East, Prince Rupert.

Commanding the draft on the Atlantic was Major R. W. Potts, DSO, 31, of Kingston, Ont., officer commanding the 58th Independent Field Squadron for the past year in Germany.

Special trains met the homecoming troops to carry them to their destinations across the country.
