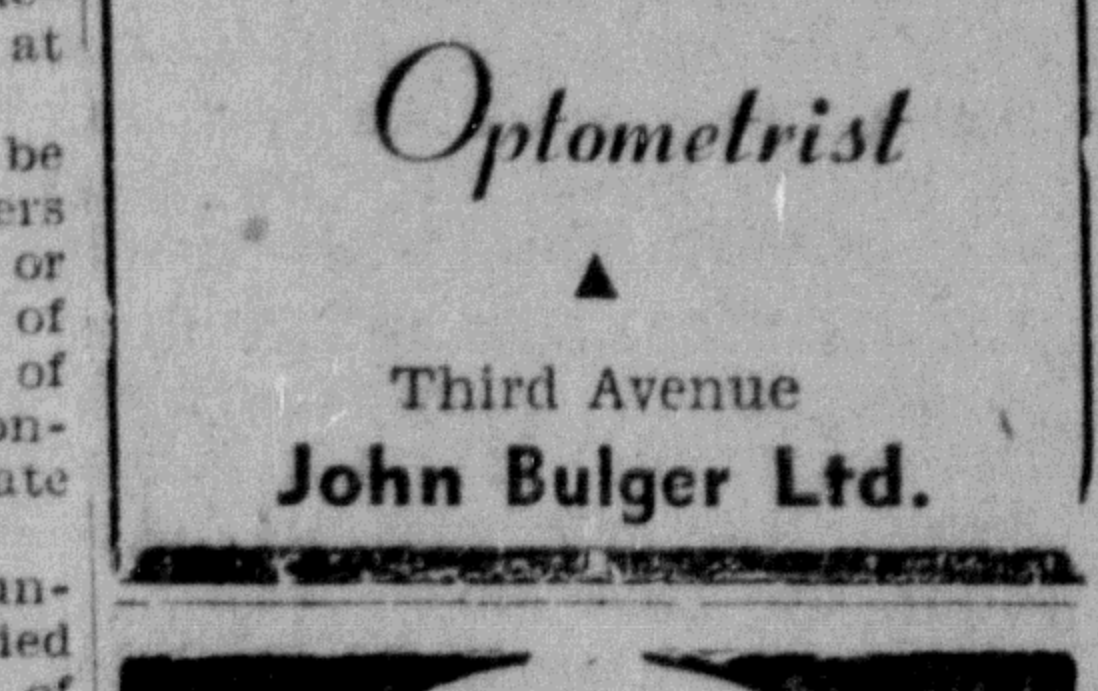
TOKYO—The Communist

 Rhee Syng Yop, former People's
 Censorship Committee Chair-
 man, the equivalent of the
 special secret police, and Pak
 Hong Wong, former vice-premier

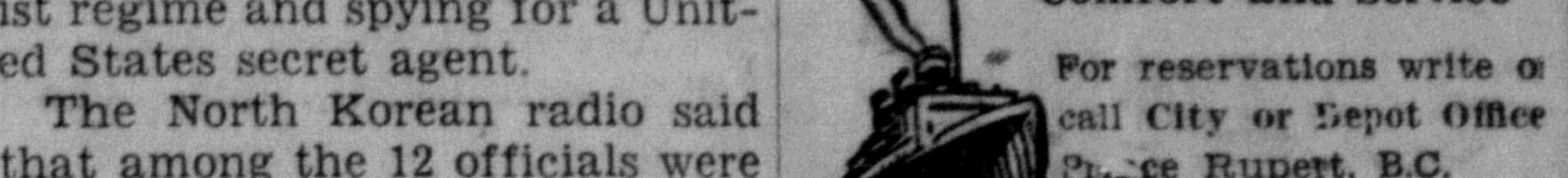

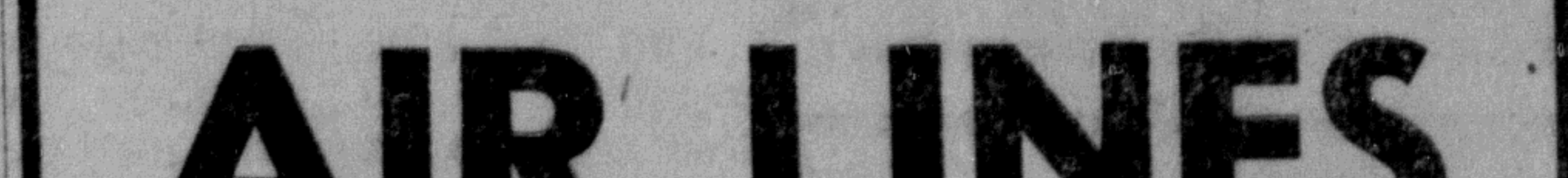
