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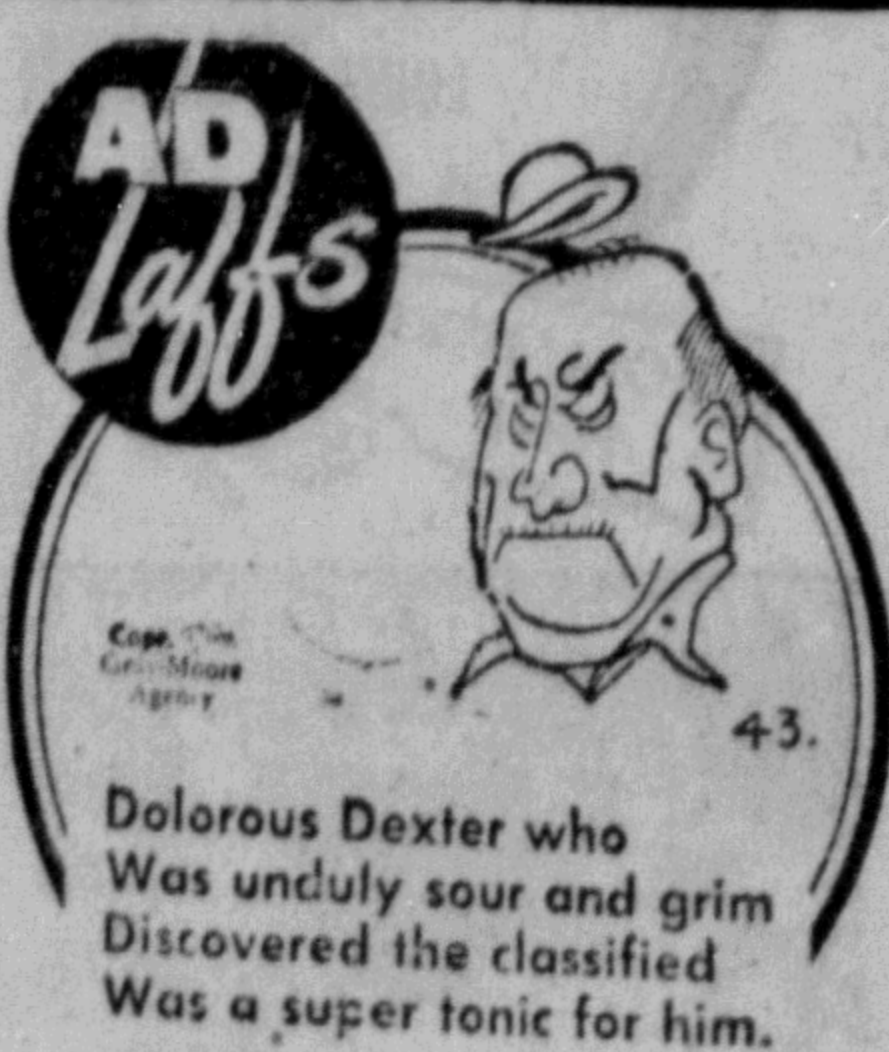

Mr. Champion used such a play in today's deal and Mr. Muzzy, who was kibitzing, didn't like it at all.

Against the three no trump contract Mr. Abel led the four of spades. Dummy's queen was put up and it held the trick. With proper play, the hand was an absolute laydown for at least nine tricks and of course Mr. Champion saw this at once.

Obviously, he could not stand a heart lead from his right but again, with proper play, there was no chance for Mr. Dale to get in.

At trick two a club was led to the ace. Next came a small diamond to dummy's king. The eight of clubs was returned and ducked, Mr. Abel winning with his lone queen.

Here Mr. Muzzy turned up his nose. "How can he finesse with nine clubs?" he muttered.

A few moments later he was to see Mr. Champion make still another "bad" play.

Mr. Abel returned the seven of spades and Mr. Dale's jack fell to the ace. The rest of the clubs were now cashed and after that Mr. Champion played the queen of diamonds and another diamond to dummy's ace. Mr. Abel had stubbornly held onto his diamonds so that Mr. Champion took exactly nine tricks—four clubs, three diamonds and two spades.

"I'd have made five," said Mr. Muzzy. "I'd drop the queen of clubs and hook the 10 of diamonds."

Mr. Champion gave him a withering look. "You're right," he answered. "Two bad plays would net you two extra tricks."

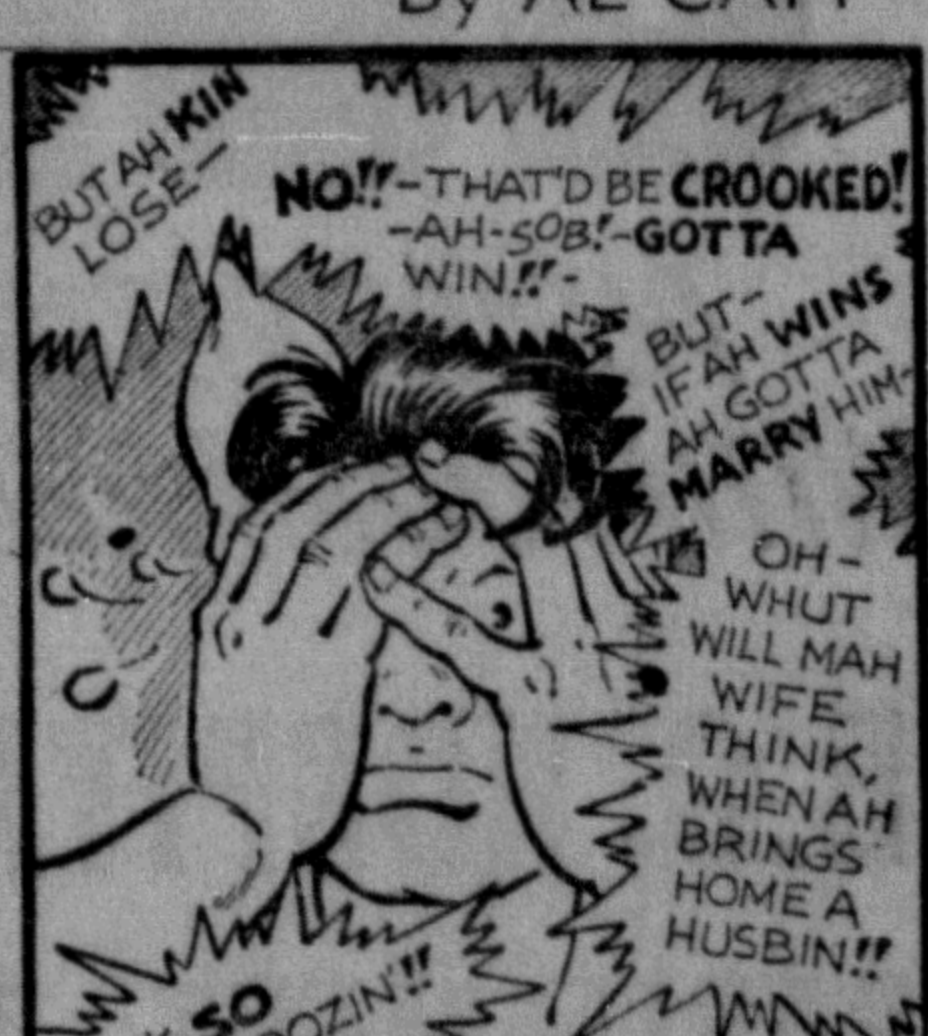
