

GORDIE HOWE PASSES 200-GOAL MARK IN NHL

Detroit's Gordie Howe reached and passed the 200-goal mark in National Hockey League competition as Red Wings downed Chicago Black Hawks 4-1 Sunday night.

In the night's other games, two goals by rookie Eric Nesterenko gave Toronto its first victory in the last six games, a 2-1 triumph over Rangers at New York.

At Boston, Milt Schmidt's second period goal was all the Bruins needed to edge Montreal 1-0, and goalie Sugar Jim Henry chalked up his seventh shutout of the season.

Howe counted twice to help his team increase its league lead to two full games over Montreal.

Tony Leswick also scored twice, both goals coming in the first period after Howe converted Ken Lindsay's pass into the goal at 1:04. Bill Mosienko counted the lone Chicago goal at 12:13 of the second period.

Combination of Errors Leads to 58-55 Defeat

Carlson stunned the spectators several times with his phenomenal shots in the first quarter as the husky centre scored 12 consecutive quick points.

While the basketball wasn't of top brand calibre, the game provided many thrills for spectators, especially in the final quarter when a sudden rally by G-As, spearheaded by Davis, got the losers within four points of winning, while gaining five of their eight-point deficit.

FUR SKINNING TIPS

HANG ANIMAL BY ITS HIND LEGS ON CORDS WITH A LARIAT KNOT FOR EACH FOOT. REMOVE ONE FOOT AT A TIME TO SKIN LEGS.

SKINNING IS EASIEST AS SOON AS POSSIBLE AFTER CATCHING. HANG BY HIND LEGS IF FORCED TO DELAY UNTIL NEXT DAY. IF WET, SHAKE TO LOOSEN THICK UNDER-FUR TO AID DRYING. DRY ALL FURS AND COMB CLEAN DRIED MUD, BURS, ETC., BEFORE SKINNING.

TO CASE-SKIN: SLIT FROM HEELS TO AND AROUND VENT CUT OFF FOOT PADS. LEAVE LAST TOE JOINTS AND CLAWS ON SKIN. PULL OUT TAIL BONE. PEEL SKIN, INSIDE OUT. FREE FRONT TOES, EARS AT BASE, ETC. WITH KNIFE.
