VICTORIA (CP)—The "new look" in British Columbia vehicle plates was shown for the first time last week. Plates for commercial vehicles will be black with yellow figures with no tab. Private car plates remain unchanged and the "54" tab will be black and yellow.

Labor Party Retains Seat

LONDON (Reuters)—The Labor party retained the parliamentary seat of North Paddington, London, in a by-election, but with a smaller majority than it obtained in the 1951 general election. Benjamin Parkin, Labor, polled 14,274 votes to 12,014 for John Eden, nephew of Foreign Secretary Anthony Eden.

Red Plot Quashed

DUSSELDORF, Germany (AP)—Police here reported the smashing of a Communist plot in the Ruhr Valley to protest West German rearmament through widespread strikes. Police said 11 Red leaders were arrested in a series of raids, and the apartments of 87 other suspects were searched.
